

**John 20:1~** On the first day of the week Mary Magdalene came to the memorial tomb early, while there was still darkness, and she beheld the stone already taken away from the memorial tomb.

1· Then after the Sabbath on the first day of the week, Mary Magdalene came to the memorial tomb, while it was just getting light, early in the morning. Upon arriving there, she found that the large stone blocking the entrance, had been removed from before the entrance.

[Question] When did Mary Magdalene return to the memorial tomb?

[Question] What did she find upon arriving at the tomb entrance?

2· And he must wave the sheaf to and fro before Yehowah, to gain approval for you. Directly, the **day** after the Sabbath, the priest should wave it to and fro. (**Leviticus 23:11**)

[Question] What offering was to be made in ancient Israel the day after the Sabbath, and how was this offered?

3· However, now Christ has been raised up from the dead, the firstfruits of those who have fallen asleep in death. (**1 Corinthians 15:20**)

[Question] What does Jesus Christ represent, among all the fallen dead of mankind?

4· After the Sabbath, when it was growing light on the first **day** of the **week**, **Mary Magdalene** and the other **Mary** came to view the grave. (**Matthew 28:1**)

[Question] What time of day was it, when Mary Magdalene arrived at the tomb of Jesus, and who accompanied her there?

5· So when the Sabbath had passed, **Mary Magdalene**, and **Mary** the mother of James, and **Salome**, bought spices, in order to come and grease him. (**Mark 16:1**)

[Question] Who also accompanied Mary Magdalene there to the tomb of Jesus, on the day after the Sabbath?

6· On the first **day** of the **week**, however, they went very **early** to the **tomb**, bearing the spices they had prepared. (**Luke 24:1**)

**[Question]** What day of the week was it, when they went out to Jesus' tomb, and what were they bringing with them, for what purpose?

- 7· And very **early** on the first **day** of the **week** they **came** to the **memorial tomb**, when the sun had risen. (**Mark 16:2**)

**[Question]** What time of day was it, when they arrived at the tomb?

- 8· Jesus said; Take the **stone** away. Martha, the sister of the deceased, said to him; Lord, by now he must smell, for it is four days. (**John 11:39**)

**[Question]** What did Martha tell Jesus, when he resurrected her brother Lazarus?
