Jesus said to her; Woman, why are you weeping? Whom are you looking for? She, imagining it was the gardener, said to him; Sir, if you have carried him off, tell me where you have laid him, and I will take him away.

1. So Jesus also asked her why she was weeping, and who she was there looking for. Yet she imagined that the man she was talking to was the gardener. So she addressed him, and told him, that if he had carried off Jesus' body, that she wanted to know where he had taken it, so that she could take him away for burial.

[Question] Who did Mary imagine, that she was actually speaking to, and so what did she say to Jesus?

2. Then Jesus turned and, getting a view of them following, he said to them; What are you looking for? They said to him; Rabbi, which means, when translated, Teacher, where are you staying? (John 1:38)

[Question] How did Jesus' disciples customarily address him, showing respect?
