^{John 20:19~} Therefore, when it was late on that day, the first of the week, and, although the doors were locked where the disciples were for fear of the Jews, Jesus came, and stood in their midst, and said to them; May you have peace.

1. So then, later that same day, the first day of the week, and although the room where the disciples were staying was locked, out of fear of the Jews, Jesus came, and stood in their midst, and bid them to have peace.

[Question] What happened later that same day, and where were the apostles then staying, and why were the doors locked?

On the first day of the week, however, they went very early to the tomb, bearing the spices they had prepared. (Luke 24:1)

[Question] Where did these women go to, on the first day of the week, and for what purpose?

3. His parents said these things because they were in fear of the Jews, for the Jews had already come to an agreement that, if anyone confessed him as Christ, he should get expelled from the synagogue. (John 9:22)

[Question] How did many in Jerusalem then feel, and why?

4 And that he appeared to Cephas, then to the twelve. (1 Corinthians 15:5)

[Question] Who did Jesus first appear to among his apostles?

5. When you are entering into the house, greet the household. (Matthew 10:12)

[Question] What did Jesus earlier tell his disciples, to offer to any household they entered in their ministry?

6 Wherever you enter into a house say first; May this house have peace. (Luke 10:5)

[Question] How were his disciples to address a household, when entering it in their ministry?

7. While they were speaking of these things he himself stood in their midst and said to them; May you have peace. (Luke

24:36)

[Question] Where did Jesus then enter, though the doors were locked, and what did he say to all assembled there?

8. At that their eyes were fully opened, and they recognized him; and he disappeared from them. (Luke 24:31)

[Question] Who did Jesus later appear to that same day, near the end of the day, and how did they come to recognize him?

9 Well, eight days later his disciples were again indoors, and Thomas with them. Jesus came, although the doors were locked, and he stood in their midst and said; May you have peace. (John 20:26)

[Question] Why did Jesus later appear again to his apostles, for who had been missing the first time he appeared to them, and how did he greet them?

10" This was now the third time, that Jesus appeared to the disciples, after his being raised up from the dead. (John 21:14)

[Question] What was the third occasion, that Jesus appeared to his disciples?

11. To these also by many positive proofs he showed himself alive, after he had suffered, being seen by them throughout forty days, and telling the things about the kingdom of God. (Acts of Apostles 1:3)

[Question] How did Jesus later show himself to be alive, and for how long a period of time?

[Question] What things, did he then relate to them in detail?
