Therefore she ran and came to Simon Peter and to the other disciple, for whom Jesus had affection, and she said to them; They have taken away the Lord¹ out of the memorial tomb, and we do not know where they have laid him.

Footnote: Or, Master

1. Therefore, upon seeing the tomb empty, she ran to tell Peter and John, and upon arriving where they were, she said to them; They have taken the Lord away! And; We do not know where they have laid him!

[Question] What did Mary Magdalene do, upon seeing that the tomb was empty, and what did she bear witness to?

2. There was reclining in front of Jesus' bosom one of his disciples, and Jesus loved him. (John 13:23)

[Question] How is the apostle John described often in scripture?

3. Therefore Jesus, seeing his mother and the disciple whom he loved standing by, said to his mother; Woman, see! Your son! (John 19:26)

[Question] How had Jesus entrusted the care of his mother Mary to John his apostle, when near to death?

4. This is the disciple that bears witness about these things, and that wrote these things, and we know, that the witness he gives is true. (John 21:24)

[Question] Who is also the one who wrote this gospel of Jesus' life?

5. Incidentally, at the place where he was impaled, there was a garden, and in the garden a new memorial tomb, in which no one had ever yet been laid. (John 19:41)

[Question] Where was this tomb located, and what was there also?
[Question] Had anyone else ever been laid in this memorial tomb, since it had been constructed?

6 Therefore, that disciple whom Jesus used to love said to Peter; It is the Lord! Hence Simon Peter, upon hearing that it was the Lord, girded about himself his top garment, for he was naked, and plunged into the sea. (John 21:7)
