**[Question]** What commission did Jesus impart to all his faithful disciples, to carry forth into all the world?

[Question] Why had Yehowah God sent Jesus forth into the world, and so what work must his faithful disciples continue in, until he returns?

6 And the things you heard from me with the support of many witnesses, these things, commit to faithful men, who, in turn, will be adequately qualified to teach others. (2 Timothy 2:2)
