

John 20:24~ But Thomas, one of the twelve, who was called The Twin,¹ was not with them when Jesus came.

Footnote: Or, Didymous Greek, *Di'dy·mos*; Latin, *Di'dy·mus*

1· However Thomas, the one called the twin, one of his twelve apostles, had not been with them when Jesus first appeared to them.

[Question] Who was not with the apostles, when Jesus appeared to them the first time?

2· Therefore Thomas, who was called The Twin, said to his fellow disciples; Let us also go, that we may die with him. (John 11:16)

[Question] How willing was Thomas, on another occasion, to even die with Jesus?

3· There were in company Simon Peter and Thomas, who was called The Twin, and Nathanael from Cana of Galilee, and the sons of Zebedee, and two others of his disciples. (John 21:2)

[Question] How was Thomas also known?
