John 20:25~ Consequently the other disciples would say to him; We have seen the Lord! But he said to them; Unless I see in his hands the print of the nails, and stick my finger into the print of the nails, and stick my hand into his side, I will certainly not believe.

1. So when the other apostles all told Thomas, that they had seen Jesus, yet Thomas remained unbelieving, stating that he would have to see this for himself to believe. For unless he saw the nail prints, and the spear cut, he would not believe.

[Question] What had Thomas failed to see, that all the others did see and touch, on his first appearance among them?

[Question] What did Thomas state, that he would have to see for himself to believe?

2. Yet one of the soldiers jabbed his side with a spear, and immediately blood and water came out. (John 19:34)

[Question] Why did Jesus come to have a spear wound in his side, and when was this done to him?

3. For we are walking by faith, not by sight. (2 Corinthians 5:7)

[Question] What do true anointed Christians walk by?

4. And I did not put faith in their words until I had come, that my own eyes might see, and, look! There has not been told me the half, of the abundance of your wisdom. You have surpassed the report that I have heard. (2 Chronicles 9:6)

[Question] What did the Queen of Sheba attest to, only after seeing it for herself?

5. For dogs have surrounded me, the assembly of evildoers themselves have enclosed me. Like a lion, they are at my hands and my feet. (Psalms 22:16)

[Question] How does the Psalmist show, the way that the wicked men around the Messiah would treat him?

6. And blotted out the handwritten document against us, which consisted of decrees, and which was in opposition to us, and He has taken it out of the way, by nailing it to the torture stake. (Colossians 2:14)
