1. Yet John had written these things down, so that men following after him, might believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God, because to all those believing, there is the hope of life eternal.

**[Question]** What did John write in his first letter, that results from faith in Jesus Christ?

7. Whereas many have undertaken to compile a statement of

## the facts, that are given full credence among us. (Luke 1:1)

**[Question]** What did many in the First Century undertake to do, and how many of those accounts have been preserved for us today?

8. In answer the angel said to her; Holy Spirit will come upon you, and power of the Most High will overshadow you. For that reason also, what is born, will be called holy, God's Son. (Luke 1:35)

**[Question]** What was Mary told before the birth of her son, and what would this son become before God?

 9. For God loved the world so much that he gave his onlybegotten Son, in order, that everyone exercising faith in him, might not be destroyed, but have everlasting life. (John 3:16)

[Question] What shows the great love that Yehowah God has for mankind?

**[Question]** What is gained, by believing in Jesus Christ, and what do all such ones avoid?

10. And he that has seen it has borne witness, and his witness is true, and that man knows he tells true things, in order, that you also may believe. (John 19:35)

**[Question]** How was John himself, well qualified to tell this account, and what did he always speak?

11. In answer Thomas said to him; My Lord, and my God! (John 20:28)

**[Question]** How did Thomas respond to seeing Jesus' wounds in his flesh and touching them?

12. Nevertheless, the reason why I was shown mercy, was that by means of me, as the foremost case, Christ Jesus might demonstrate all his long-suffering, for a sample of those, who are going to rest their faith on him for everlasting life. (1 Timothy 1:16)

**[Question]** What did the apostle Paul serve as, to his fellow believers, and to future fellow believers?

13. And that from infancy you have known the holy writings, which are able to make you wise for salvation through the

## faith in connection with Christ Jesus. (2 Timothy 3:15)

**[Question]** What writings, was Timothy well versed in, and from what point in his life?

[Question] What can these holy writings do for a person, who studies and believes them?

14. Who is the one that conquers the world but he who has faith, that Jesus is the Son of God? (1 John 5:5)

[Question] What is required to conquer the world?

15. And to the angel of the congregation in Thyatira write. These are the things that the Son of God says, he who has his eyes like a fiery flame, and his feet are like fine copper. (Revelation 2:18)
