

John 20:9~ For they did not yet discern the scripture, that he must rise from the dead.

- 1· For none of Jesus' disciples had yet discerned the scripture, that he must rise from the dead.

[Question] What scripture, did none of Jesus' disciples yet discern, though Jesus had referenced it many times?

- 2· For you will not leave my soul in Sheol. You will not allow your loyal one to see the pit. (**Psalms 16:10**)

[Question] What did the Psalms show, about how Yehowah God would treat his Messiah in death?

- 3· But Yehowah himself took delight in crushing him. He made him sick. If you will set his soul as a guilt offering, he will see his offspring, he will prolong his days, and in his hand, what is the delight of Yehowah will succeed. (**Isaiah 53:10**)

[Question] Why did Yehowah God crush his son, for what must he serve as for mankind?

[Question] Whose delight would succeed through him?

- 4· From that time forward Jesus Christ commenced showing his disciples, that he **must** go to Jerusalem and suffer many things, from the older men and chief priests and scribes, and be killed, and on the third day, be raised up. (**Matthew 16:21**)

[Question] What did Jesus start telling his disciples, while they were on the way to Jerusalem, on that final trip there?

- 5· When, though, he was raised up from the **dead**, his disciples called to mind, that he used to say this, and they believed the Scripture, and the saying that Jesus said. (**John 2:22**)

[Question] What did Jesus' disciples only recognize for themselves after his resurrection?

- 6· Because you will not leave my soul in Hades, neither will you allow your loyal one to see corruption. (**Acts of Apostles 2:27**)

[Question] What did the Psalms state, about the soul of the Messiah?

- 7· **And that he was buried, yes, that he has been raised up the third day, according to the Scriptures. (1 Corinthians 15:4)**

[Question] What did Paul later bear witness, to about the resurrection of Jesus Christ?

- 8· **Was it not necessary for the Christ to suffer these things, and to enter into his glory? (Luke 24:26)**

[Question] What did Jesus himself make known to two of his disciples, while walking along the road with them after his resurrection?

- 9· **Therefore the crowd answered him; We heard from the Law, that the Christ remains forever, and how is it you say, that the Son of man **must** be lifted up? Who is this Son of man? (John 12:34)**

[Question] How did the crowds show, that they did not understand about the death and resurrection of the Christ?
