

John 21:12~ Jesus said to them; Come, take your breakfast. Not one of the disciples had the courage to inquire of him; Who are you? Because they knew it was the Lord.

1· So Jesus motioned them to come forward and to take their breakfast from the prepared foods, and from the fishes that they had just caught. Yet though they knew it was the Lord, not one of them had the courage to ask him.

[Question] What did Jesus then motion for them all to come forward and do?

[Question] What did they then know, but were afraid to ask?

2· Not to all the people, but to witnesses appointed beforehand by God, to us, who ate and drank with him after his rising from the dead. (**Acts of Apostles 10:41**)

[Question] Who did Peter later testify Jesus had appeared to, and who chose whom Jesus would appear to?

3· When, now, they had breakfasted, Jesus **said** to Simon Peter; Simon son of John, do you love me more than these? He **said** to him; Yes, **Lord**, you know I have affection for you. He **said** to him Feed my lambs. (**John 21:15**)

[Question] What question did Jesus ask of Peter, after they ate breakfast?

[Question] What were these men doing, rather than feeding his lambs?
