John 21:19~ This he said to signify, by what sort of death he would glorify God. So, when he had said this, he said to him; Continue following me.

1. So Jesus said this to signify with what sort of a death Peter would glorify God. The scriptures do not record that death, but since John outlived Peter by more than thirty years, John must have known, and here he bears witness to it. So then, once Jesus had said this, he also said to Peter; Continue following me!

[Question] What do the scriptures not detail, but who must have known how Peter died?

[Question] What counsel did Jesus now give to Peter?
