

John 21:2~ There were in company Simon Peter and Thomas, who was called The Twin, and Nathanael from Cana of Galilee, and the sons of Zebedee, and two others of his disciples.

1· There were seven of his disciples there fishing in the boat on the Sea of Galilee, Simon Peter, Thomas, Nathanael, James and John and two others.

[Question] How many of his disciples were then in the boat fishing, and which ones are named?

2· Therefore **Thomas**, who was called The **Twin**, said to his fellow **disciples**; Let us also go, that we may die with him. (**John 11:16**)

[Question] How did Thomas earlier feel about following Jesus, wherever he went?

3· But **Thomas**, one of the twelve, who was called The **Twin**, was not with them when Jesus came. (**John 20:24**)

[Question] Who had not been present, the first time Jesus appeared to his disciples, after his resurrection?

4· Philip found **Nathanael** and said to him; We have found the one of whom Moses, in the Law and the Prophets wrote, Jesus, the son of Joseph, from Nazareth. (**John 1:45**)

[Question] What did Phillip do, after finding the Messiah?

5· Going on also from there, he saw **two** others who were brothers, James the son of **Zebedee**, and John his brother, in the boat with **Zebedee** their father, mending their nets, and he called them. (**Matthew 4:21**)

[Question] Where had Jesus first found James and John, at the beginning of his ministry?

6· Now on the third day, a marriage feast took place in **Cana of Galilee**, and the mother of Jesus was there. (**John 2:1**)

[Question] What was the first miracle of Jesus' ministry, and where was it performed?

7· Accordingly he came again to **Cana of Galilee**, where he had turned the water into wine. Now there was a certain

**attendant of the king whose son was sick in Capernaum.
(John 4:46)**

[Question] What miracle did Jesus perform at Cana of Galilee?
