

**John 21:20~** Upon turning about, Peter saw the disciple whom Jesus used to love<sup>1</sup> following, the one who at the evening meal, had also leaned back upon his breast, and said; Lord, who is the one betraying you?

**Footnote: Or, prefer**

**1· So Peter, turning about, saw the disciple John, whom Jesus used to love, whom Peter had asked at the evening meal, about the one betraying him.**

**[Question]** Who did Peter see upon turning around, and what question did this one earlier ask of Jesus, at the Memorial celebration?

**2· There was reclining in front of Jesus' bosom one of his disciples, and Jesus loved him. (John 13:23)**

**[Question]** How did John describe himself in his gospel account in several places?

**3· Therefore she ran and came to Simon Peter, and to the other disciple, for whom Jesus had affection, and she said to them; They have taken away the Lord out of the memorial tomb, and we do not know where they have laid him. (John 20:2)**

**[Question]** Whom did Mary come and report to, upon seeing the empty tomb of Jesus?

**4· So the latter leaned back upon the breast of Jesus and said to him; Lord, who is it? (John 13:25)**

**[Question]** What question did John ask of Jesus on the night of the Memorial, about Jesus' betrayer?

**5· Therefore Jesus, seeing his mother, and the disciple whom he loved standing by, said to his mother; Woman, see! Your son! (John 19:26)**

**[Question]** How did Jesus want his own mother to be cared for in the future, and whose care did he leave her in?

**6· A revelation by Jesus Christ, which God gave him, to show his slaves, the things that must shortly take place. And he sent forth his angel, and presented it in signs through him, to his slave John. (Revelation 1:1)**

**[Question]** Who gave the Revelation account to Jesus Christ, and for what purpose?
