

John 21:22~ Jesus said to him; If it is my will for him to remain until I come, of what concern is that to you? You continue following me.

1· So Jesus showed, that our service to God is individual, and not exercised in reference to any other person, but toward God alone. So Jesus said in answer to Peter's question, that it was not Peter's concern, even if Jesus had wanted to let John remain until his return. Peter then was counseled to continue following Christ! That is what each and every one of his disciples must do, always.

[Question] What did Jesus' answer show, about our personal service to Yehowah God?

[Question] What did Jesus then show, was simply not Peter's concern?

[Question] What counsel, did Jesus give for Peter to follow after?

2· For the Son of man is destined to **come in the glory of his Father with his angels, and then he **will** recompense each one, according to his behavior. (**Matthew 16:27**)**

[Question] When, and how, will the Son of Man return, and what will he do then?

3· When the Son of man arrives in his glory, and all the angels with him, then he **will sit down on his glorious throne. (**Matthew 25:31**)**

[Question] Where will Christ sit, and what will he then take up, when he arrives in his glory?

4· Hence do not judge anything before the due time, **until the Lord **comes**, who **will** both bring the secret things of darkness to light and make the counsels of the hearts manifest, and then each one **will** have his praise **come** to him from God. (**1 Corinthians 4:5**)**

[Question] Why are Christians encouraged not to prejudge matters of faith, for what will Christ alone make manifest, and when?

[Question] Who are all spirit anointed Christians serving, and who is ultimately their judge?

5· By inspiration I came to be in the Lord's day, and I heard behind me a strong voice like that of a trumpet.

(Revelation 1:10)

[Question] Where did John later come to find himself, under inspiration, in a vision?

- 6· **He that bears witness of these things says; Yes, I am coming quickly. Amen! Come, Lord Jesus. (Revelation 22:20)**

[Question] What does John bear witness to about the coming of Christ?
