1. John then confesses, that there were in fact many other things that Jesus did, and he postulates, that if ever the complete story of his marvelous works and teachings was ever told in full, that the world itself could not contain them.

[Question] What did John show it would take, to contain all the things Jesus did and said, during his short three and one-half year ministry to Israel?

2. To be sure, Jesus performed many other signs also before the disciples, which are not written down in this scroll. (John 20:30)

[Question] Where all of the events of Jesus' life and his teachings written down for future generations?
