**[Question]** How did the women feel, when finding Jesus' memorial tomb empty?

**5·** He said; Come! Thereupon Peter, getting down off the boat, walked over the waters, and went toward Jesus. (Matthew 14:29)

**[Question]** What extraordinary faith, had Peter previously exercised?

**6·** Seeing this, Simon Peter fell down at the knees of Jesus,

saying; Depart from me, because I am a sinful man, **Lord**.  
(**Luke 5:8**)

**[Question]** How did Peter feel, after the first miraculous catch of fish Jesus gave to him?

- 7· This is the disciple that bears witness **about** these things and that wrote these things, and we know that the witness he gives is true. (**John 21:24**)
