John 2:10~ And said to him; Every other man puts out the fine wine first, and when people are intoxicated, the inferior. You, have reserved the fine wine until now.

1. So the director of the feast called the groom to himself and told him, that at most weddings, they put out the fine wine first, and then when people are intoxicated, they bring out wine that is inferior. Yet he congratulated the groom, for saving the finest wine for last. Thus he testified, that this was a superior wine, indeed a god-given vintage.
