

John 2:11~ Jesus performed this in Cana of Galilee, as the beginning of his signs, and he made his glory manifest, and his disciples put their faith in him.

- 1· This was Jesus' first miracle, that he performed in Cana of Galilee, as the beginning of his many signs, and through it, he made his glory manifest to his disciples, who then put their faith in him.

[Question] What did this first make manifest to Jesus' disciples?

- 2· However, the obscureness, will not be as when the land had stress, as at the former time, when one treated with contempt the land of Zebulun and the land of Naphtali, and when, at the later time, one caused it to be honored, the way by the sea, in the region of the Jordan, Galilee of the nations. (**Isaiah 9:1**)

[Question] What prophecy had Isaiah made respecting the land of Galilee?

- 3· So the Word became flesh and resided among us, and we had a view of his glory, a glory such as belongs to an only-begotten son from a father, and he was full of undeserved kindness and truth. (**John 1:14**)

[Question] What did the Word of God become, in the person of Jesus Christ, and what was evident about this one, to men who knew him?

- 4· This one came to him in the night and said to him; Rabbi, we know that you as a teacher have come from God, for no one can perform these signs that you perform unless God is with him. (**John 3:2**)

[Question] What did Nicodemus tell Jesus, that the Pharisees knew about Jesus?

- 5· Accordingly he came again to Cana of Galilee, where he had turned the water into wine. Now there was a certain attendant of the king whose son was sick in Capernaum. (**John 4:46**)

[Question] Where was it, that Jesus turned the water into wine?

- 6· Again this was the second sign Jesus performed, when he

came out of Judea into Galilee. (John 4:54)

[Question] What was the second sign Jesus performed, at the start of his earthly ministry?
