

John 2:12~ After this, he and his mother and brothers, and his disciples, went down to Capernaum, but they did not stay there many days.

- 1· So after this wedding he and his mother and brothers, and his disciples went down to Capernaum, yet they did not stay there many days.

[Question] Where did Jesus and members of his family then go to, and how long did they stay there?

- 2· While he was yet speaking to the crowds, look! His **mother** and **brothers** took up a position outside seeking to speak to him. (**Matthew 12:46**)

[Question] Who came down to Jesus to speak to him?

- 3· Is this not the carpenter's son? Is not his **mother** called Mary, and his **brothers** James and Joseph, and Simon and Judas? (**Matthew 13:55**)

[Question] How was Jesus then known in his hometown area, and who were his brothers?

- 4· Now his **mother** and his **brothers** came, and as they were standing on the outside, they sent in to him to call him. (**Mark 3:31**)

[Question] Who came to Jesus to speak to him during the early part of his ministry?

- 5· Now his **mother** and **brothers** came toward him, but they were unable to get to him, because of the crowd. (**Luke 8:19**)

[Question] Why could his family members not gain direct access to Jesus at first?

- 6· With one accord, all these were persisting in prayer, together with some women, and Mary the **mother** of Jesus, and with his **brothers**. (**Acts of Apostles 1:14**)

[Question] Who was present on the day of Pentecost, when the Holy Spirit was poured out upon Jesus' disciples?

- 7· We have authority to lead about a sister as a wife, even as

the rest of the apostles and the Lord's **brothers and Cephas, do we not? (1 Corinthians 9:5)**

[Question] What authority did all the apostles have, and is it right to state that Christians cannot marry?

8· But I saw no one else of the apostles, only James the brother of the Lord. (Galatians 1:19)

[Question] Who did Paul visit with, when he first visited Jerusalem, three years after becoming a Christian?

9· Further, after leaving Nazareth, he came and took up residence in **Capernaum beside the sea, in the districts of Zebulun and Naphtali. (Matthew 4:13)**

[Question] Where did Jesus take up residence after leaving Nazareth, and where is this city located, and what is it near to?

10· And his sisters, are they not all with us? Where, then, did this man get all these things? (Matthew 13:56)

[Question] What did Jesus also have more than one of, and so did his mother Mary remain a virgin?

11· Therefore his **brothers said to him; Pass on over from here and go into Judea, in order, that your **disciples** also may behold the works you do. (John 7:3)**

[Question] What did Jesus' brothers counsel him to do, to make himself better known in Judea?
