 - 1. So Jesus made a whip of ropes and he drove all those with the sheep and cattle out of the temple area, and he also poured out the coins of the money changers, and overturned their tables.
 - [Question] How did Jesus then handle this situation, of men making money within Yehowah God's temple?
 - 2. And Jesus entered into the temple and threw out all those selling and buying in the temple, and overturned the tables of the money changers, and the benches of those selling doves. (Matthew 21:12)
 - [Question] Where did Jesus then enter, and what did he do to those buying and selling within the temple?
 - 3. Now they came to Jerusalem. There he entered into the temple and started to throw out, those selling and buying in the temple, and he overturned the tables of the money changers, and the benches of those selling doves. (Mark 11:15)
 - [Question] What did Jesus do to those, who made a business of the temple and the worship of Yehowah God?
 - 4. And he entered into the temple and started to throw out those who were selling. (Luke 19:45)
 - [Question] What did Jesus do upon entering the temple area?
 - 5. And his heart became bold in the ways of Yehowah, and he even removed the high places and the sacred poles from Judah. (2 Chronicles 17:6)
 - [Question] How did many of the kings of Israel show similar zeal for Yehowah God's true worship?
