

John 2:16~ **And he said to those selling the doves; Take these things away from here! Stop making the house of my Father a house of merchandise!**

- 1· Also he told those selling the doves for sacrifice, to take away these things from his father's house of prayer and worship. For they were making it a business, a place of merchandise.**

[Question] What did Jesus then tell those ones, buying and selling within his Father's house of worship, for what were they making it into?

- 2· Your own reminders have proved very trustworthy. Holiness is befitting to your own house, O Yehowah, for length of days. (Psalms 93:5)**

[Question] What did the Psalmist show was befitting to Yehowah's house?

- 3· But he said to them; Why did you have to go looking for me? Did you not know that I must be in the house of my Father? (Luke 2:49)**

[Question] What question did Jesus pose to his parents when they found him within the temple?

- 4· Has this house upon which my name has been called, become a mere cave of robbers in your eyes? Here I myself also have seen it, is the utterance of Yehowah. (Jeremiah 7:11)**

[Question] What had Jeremiah prophesied about the temple?

- 5· And he said to them; It is written: My house will be called a house of prayer, but you are making it a cave of robbers. (Matthew 21:13)**

[Question] What did Jesus apply the prophecy of Jeremiah to?

- 6· But he kept teaching and saying; Is it not written: My house will be called a house of prayer for all the nations? But you have made it a cave of robbers. (Mark 11:17)**

[Question] What authority did Jesus quote from, to show why he was doing such things within the temple?

- 7· **Saying to them; It is written: And my house will be a house of prayer, but you made it a cave of robbers. (Luke 19:46)**

[Question] What did Jesus use as authority for his actions, for what were these men making of his Father's house of worship?
