

John 2:22~ When, though, he was raised up from the dead, his disciples called to mind, that he used to say this, and they believed the Scripture, and the saying that Jesus said.

- 1· So long after that, when he himself had been resurrected, his disciples recalled to their minds, that he used to say this, and then they got the point and believed the scripture, and the saying that Jesus had made prior to this.

[Question] When did Jesus disciples first come to understand these sayings correctly?

- 2· So they called his sayings to mind. (Luke 24:8)

[Question] What did Jesus disciples realize only later, after the fact?

- 3· These things his disciples took no note of at first, but when Jesus became glorified, then they called to mind, that these things were written respecting him, and that they did these things to him. (John 12:16)

[Question] How did Jesus' disciples feel upon first hearing these statements of his, yet what did they later realize fully?

- 4· But the helper, the Holy Spirit, which the Father will send in my name, that one will teach you all things, and bring back to your minds, all the things I told you. (John 14:26)

[Question] What did Jesus tell his disciples that would continue to teach them, and what would it help them to remember?

- 5· For they did not yet discern the scripture, that he must rise from the dead. (John 20:9)

[Question] What scripture did Jesus' disciples not yet fully discern?
