

John 2:23~ However, when he was in Jerusalem at the Passover, at its festival, many people put their faith in his name, viewing his signs that he was performing.

- 1· So while Jesus was at this Passover, there were many people there for the celebration, who then put their faith in him, after viewing the signs that he was performing.

[Question] What did many people then at the Passover view, and how did this affect them?

- 2· When, therefore, he arrived in Galilee, the Galileans received him, because they had seen all the things he did in Jerusalem at the festival, for they also had gone to the festival. (John 4:45)

[Question] How did the people of Galilee view him, when he returned there after visiting Jerusalem, and seeing him performing many signs there?

- 3· If we let him alone this way, they will all put faith in him, and the Romans will come and take away both our place and our nation. (John 11:48)

[Question] What did the religious leaders of the Jews fear would happen, if they let Jesus alone?

- 4· Still, many of the crowd put faith in him, and they commenced saying; When the Christ arrives, he will not perform more signs than this man has performed, will he? (John 7:31)

[Question] Why did many of the Jews though, put their faith in Jesus, and what did they say about him?

- 5· But a great crowd kept following him, because they were beholding the signs he was performing upon those who were ill. (John 6:2)

[Question] Who then, kept following Jesus, and why?

- 6· Therefore many of the Jews that had come to Mary, and that beheld what he did, put faith in him. (John 11:45)

[Question] Who then, put their faith in Jesus, and why?
