

**John 2:24~**

**But Jesus himself was not entrusting himself to them, because of his knowing them all.**

- 1· Yet Jesus himself was not trusting the people, for he knew what was in them, for he knew their thoughts.**

**[Question]** What did Jesus know about the people, and so did he have reason not to trust them?

- 2· Therefore Jesus, **knowing** they were about to come and seize him to make him king, withdrew again into the mountain all alone. (John 6:15)**

**[Question]** What did Jesus know, that men were about to do before they tried to do it, and what did this show that he knew?

- 3· He, however, knew their reasonings, yet he said to the man with the withered hand; Get up and stand in the center. And he rose and took his stand. (Luke 6:8)**

**[Question]** What did Jesus show that he knew, even though men spoke nothing?

- 4· But there are some of you that do not believe. For from the beginning Jesus knew who were the ones not believing, and who was the one that would betray him. (John 6:64)**

**[Question]** What did Jesus know from the beginning about those putting faith in him, and about his betrayer?

- 5· He said to him the third time; Simon son of John, do you have affection for me? Peter became grieved that he said to him the third time; Do you have affection for me? So he said to him; Lord, you know all things, you are aware that I have affection for you. Jesus said to him; Feed my little sheep. (John 21:17)**

**[Question]** What did Jesus tell Peter, that was his responsibility toward the flock, if he loved Jesus?
