And because he was in no need to have anyone bear witness about man, for he himself knew what was in man.

1. Jesus had no need for anyone else to bear witness to him about man, for he himself knew what was within man.

[Question] What did Jesus know about other men, that men generally do not understand about other men?

2. And Jesus, knowing their thoughts, said; Why are you thinking wicked things in your hearts? (Matthew 9:4)

[Question] What did Jesus show many times, that he knew, while men were still thinking them?

3. But Jesus, having discerned immediately by his spirit, that they were reasoning that way in themselves, said to them; Why are you reasoning these things in your hearts? (Mark 2:8)

[Question] What did Jesus state to opposers, and how did Jesus discern this about his opposers hearts and thinking?

4. Nathanael said to him; How does it come that you know me? Jesus in answer said to him; Before Philip called you, while you were under the fig tree, I saw you. (John 1:48)

[Question] What surprised Nathanael when he first spoke to Jesus, and what did this ability prove to Nathanael?

5. But there are some of you that do not believe. For from the beginning, Jesus knew who were the ones not believing, and who was the one that would betray him. (John 6:64)

[Question] What did Jesus know about his disciples from the beginning?

6. And her children I will kill with deadly plague, so that all the congregations will know, that I am he, who searches the kidneys and hearts, and I will give to you individually, according to your deeds. (Revelation 2:23)

[Question] What does the resurrected Jesus Christ search?

[Question] What does it mean to search the heart, and the kidneys?

7: Knowing their thoughts, he said to them; Every kingdom

divided against itself comes to desolation, and every city or house divided against itself will not stand. (Matthew 12:25)

[Question] What did Jesus know about other men, that men generally do not understand about other men?

8. Knowing their imaginations he said to them; Every kingdom divided against itself comes to desolation, and a house divided against itself falls. (Luke 11:17)

[Question] What did Jesus know about people he conversed with, and so what did he counsel them?

9. He led him to Jesus. When Jesus looked upon him he said; You are Simon the son of John, you will be called Cephas, which is translated Peter. (John 1:42)

[Question] What did Jesus know about Peter, before ever meeting him?

10" Jesus saw Nathanael coming toward him and said about him; See, an Israelite for a certainty, in whom there is no deceit. (John 1:47)

[Question] What did Jesus state about Nathanael, before he ever spoke to him?

11. Jesus knew they were wanting to question him, so he said to them; Are you inquiring among yourselves over this, because I said; In a little while you will not behold me, and, again, in a little while, you will see me? (John 16:19)

[Question] What did Jesus know, before men ever said anything, and so how did this ability help him to prepare his questions?

12. Now we know, that you know all things, and you do not need to have anyone question you. By this, we believe, that you came out from God. (John 16:30)

[Question] What did men hearing his well thought out answers, later confess?

13. He said to him the third time; Simon son of John, do you have affection for me? Peter became grieved that he said to him the third time; Do you have affection for me? So he said to him; Lord, you know all things, you are aware that

I have affection for you. Jesus said to him; Feed my little sheep. (John 21:17)

[Question] What did Peter know, that Jesus knew about him, demanding absolute honesty and integrity?

14. I know your deeds, and your labor and endurance, and that you cannot bear bad men, and that you put those to the test who say they are apostles, but they are not, and you found them liars. (Revelation 2:2)
