

John 2:4~

**But Jesus said to her; What have I to do with you, woman?<sup>1</sup> My hour has not yet come.**

**Footnote: Literally, What to me and to you? meaning What is there in common between me and you? An idiom; A repellent question indicating objection See Appendix 7B**

**1· Yet Jesus replied to his mother, that this was not his concern, for it was not yet his time.**

**[Question]** How though, did Jesus reply to his mother's request?

**2· Therefore Jesus, seeing his mother and the disciple whom he loved standing by, said to his mother; Woman, see! Your son! (John 19:26)**

**[Question]** How did Jesus feel about his mother, and whose care did he leave her in, when he himself died?

**3· You know that two days from now the Passover occurs, and the Son of man is to be delivered up to be impaled. (Matthew 26:2)**

**[Question]** What did Jesus tell his disciples would take place, two days before it did take place?

**4· Therefore Jesus said to them; My due time is not yet present, but your due time is always at hand. (John 7:6)**

**[Question]** What due time, did Jesus refer to, and why was his disciples due time always possible, and yet his was pre-set?

**5· But Jesus answered them, saying; The hour has come for the Son of man to be glorified. (John 12:23)**

**[Question]** What hour did Jesus show, had come on the night of the Memorial?
