- When, now, the director of the feast tasted the water that had been turned into wine, but did not know what its source was, although those ministering who had drawn out the water knew, the director of the feast called the bridegroom.
  - 1. Now when the director of the feast tasted the water, that had been turned into wine, he immediately called the bridegroom. Now the persons presenting the director of the feast with the water, knew about where it came from, but the director of the feast did not.

[Question] What then, did the director of the feast say, when first tasting the wine Jesus made?

[Question] What did the director of the feast then not know, about where the wine originated?

2. Accordingly he came again to Cana of Galilee, where he had turned the water into wine. Now there was a certain attendant of the king whose son was sick in Capernaum. (John 4:46)

**[Question]** Where was this, where Jesus performed his first miracle?
