

John 3:11~ Most truly I say to you, what we know we speak, and what we have seen we bear witness of, but you people do not receive the witness we give.

1· So he told Nicodemus, that what things we truly understand, we speak of, and then he added, that they did not understand these things, for they had not experienced them, and so they refused to accept the witness of others, who had experienced them.

[Question] What did Jesus then tell Nicodemus, that men speak of?

[Question] Why did Nicodemus not then understand these things?

[Question] What witness then, did Nicodemus fail to accept?

2· I **have** many things to **speak** concerning you and to pass judgment upon. As a matter of fact, he that sent me is true, and the very things I heard from him I am speaking in the world. (**John 8:26**)

[Question] What did Jesus later show his disciples, that he wanted to show them, but they were not ready for it?

3· **What** he has **seen** and heard, of this he **bears witness**, but no man is accepting his **witness**. (**John 3:32**)

[Question] What did Jesus bear witness to, that he had seen and heard in heaven, but how was this knowledge treated by men on earth?

4· But a physical man does not **receive** the things of the spirit of God, for they are foolishness to him, and he cannot get to **know** them, because they are examined spiritually. (**1 Corinthians 2:14**)

[Question] Why does a physical man not accept the things of the spirit, and why can he not get to know them?

5· Therefore Jesus said; When once you **have** lifted up the Son of man, then you will **know**, that I am he, and that I do nothing of my own initiative, but just as the Father taught me, I **speak** these things. (**John 8:28**)

[Question] What did Jesus tell his disciples, that they would come to know, when once they had lifted him up?

- 6· **And this is the message which we **have** heard from him and are announcing to you, that God is light, and there is no darkness at all in union with him. (1 John 1:5)**

[Question] What message do anointed Christians announce about Yehowah God?
