1· Thus Jesus showed, that everyone lifting him up in faith would gain everlasting life through him.

[Question] What did Jesus then show, that all those who lifted him up in faith, would gain through their faith?

2· He that exercises faith in the Son has everlasting life, he that disobeys the Son will not see life, but the wrath of God remains upon him. (John 3:36)

3· But these have been written down, that you may believe, that Jesus is the Christ the Son of God, and that, because of believing, you may have life by means of his name. (John 20:31)
