For God loved the world<sup>1</sup> so much, that he gave his onlybegotten Son, in order, that everyone exercising faith in him, might not be destroyed, but have everlasting life.

1. Jesus then showed Nicodemus, that God had a great and abiding love for mankind, his creation. He loved them so much, that he gave to them his only-begotten son, so that everyone exercising faith in this fine son, might not be destroyed, but gain everlasting life.

[Question] What did Jesus then show, that God had for mankind, and how did he show this great love?

[Question] What does Yehowah God grant to everyone exercising faith in his son?

2. The love is in this respect, not that we have loved God, but that he loved us, and sent forth his Son, as a propitiatory sacrifice for our sins. (1 John 4:10)

[Question] What love is the greatest love of all, and how was this love of God shown to mankind?

3. As for us, we love, because he first loved us. (1 John 4:19)

[Question] How do humans know love, and what it is?

4. And he went on to say; Take, please, your son, your only son whom you so love, Isaac, and make a trip to the land of Moriah and there offer him up as a burnt offering, on one of the mountains that I shall designate to you. (Genesis 22:2)

[Question] How did Yehowah God prefigure, what he would later do, through a prophetic drama using Abraham and Isaac?

5. And to say; By myself I do swear, is the utterance of Yehowah, that by reason of the fact, that you have done this thing, and you have not withheld your son, your only one. (Genesis 22:16)

[Question] How did Yehowah God come to feel about Abraham, when once he had willingly offered up Isaac as directed?

[Question] What did this require, that Abraham have in Yehowah God, for his other promises to come to fulfillment?

6. But God recommends his own love to us in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us. (Romans 5:8)

[Question] How does Yehowah God recommend his own love or mankind?

7' He who did not even spare his own Son, but delivered him up for us all, why, will he not also with him, kindly give us all other things? (Romans 8:32)

[Question] How did Yehowah God show, that he would not hold anything back from anointed Christians?

8. By this, the love of God was made manifest in our case, because God sent forth his only-begotten Son into the world, that we might gain life through him. (1 John 4:9)

[Question] How has the love of God been made manifest to anointed Christians?

9. However, as many as did receive him, to them he gave authority to become God's children, because they were exercising faith in his name. (John 1:12)

[Question] What authority did Yehowah God give to men, who put faith in his son, Jesus Christ?

10" However, Jesus cried out and said; He that puts faith in me, puts faith, not in me only, but in him also, that sent me. (John 12:44)

[Question] Whom did Jesus state, that men who put faith in him, also were putting faith in?

11. One Lord, one faith, one baptism. (Ephesians 4:5)

[Question] Should there be divisions among anointed Christians, for what things are there one only of?

12. Because to you the privilege was given in behalf of Christ, not only to put your faith in him, but also to suffer in his behalf. (Philippians 1:29)

[Question] What privilege do anointed Christians share in, like Christ, and what goes hand in hand with this?

13. And that from infancy you have known the holy writings,

which are able to make you wise for salvation through the faith in connection with Christ Jesus. (2 Timothy 3:15)

[Question] What writings did Timothy know, and from when in his life?

[Question] What were these holy writings able to do for him, and also us today?

14. And these will depart into everlasting cutting-off, but the righteous ones into everlasting life. (Matthew 25:46)

[Question] Where did Jesus show in his parable, that those putting faith in him would depart to, in Yehowah God's judgment?

[Question] Where also would those not putting faith go to?

15. For this is the will of my Father, that everyone that beholds the Son and exercises faith in him, should have everlasting life, and I will resurrect him at the last day. (John 6:40)

[Question] What is the will of the Father, Yehowah God for his anointed Christian sons, and what will he do for them later, because of their faith?

16. But these have been written down, that you may believe, that Jesus is the Christ the Son of God, and that, because of believing, you may have life by means of his name. (John 20:31)

[Question] Why have the works and teachings of Jesus Christ been written down for people today, and what can be obtained through them?

17: For the wages sin pays is death, but the gift God gives, is everlasting life by Christ Jesus our Lord. (Romans 6:23)

[Question] What do the wages of sin, pay out to mankind?

[Question] What is the free gift that Yehowah God gives to mankind through faith in his Christ?

18. I write you these things, that you may know, that you have life everlasting, you, who put your faith in the name of the Son of God. (1 John 5:13)

[Question] What did John testify, that those putting faith in Jesus Christ have, through their faith?

19. For on this day atonement will be made for you to pronounce you clean. You will be clean from all your sins before Yehowah. (Leviticus 16:30)

[Question] What standing did the Israelites gain on the Day of Atonement each year, and what did this picture?

20" What is mortal man, that you keep him in mind, and the son of earthling man, that you take care of him? (Psalms 8:4)

[Question] How did the Psalmist humbly acknowledge mankind's position before Yehowah God?

21. For there has been a child born to us, there has been a son given to us. The princely rule will come to be upon his shoulder. His name will be called, Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Eternal Father, Prince of Peace. (Isaiah 9:6)

[Question] What did Isaiah prophesy, that Yehowah God would give to his people?

[Question] What roles would this one fill for God's people?

22. Turn to me and be saved, all you at the ends of the earth, for I am God, and there is no one else. (Isaiah 45:22)

[Question] What invitation does Yehowah God give to his people, through Isaiah the prophet?

23. Look! As a witness to the national groups I have given him, as a leader and commander to the national groups. (Isaiah 55:4)

[Question] What does Isaiah state, that this one is given to the people and national groups for?

24. At this the owner of the vineyard said; What shall I do? I will send my son the beloved. Likely they will respect this one. (Luke 20:13)

[Question] How did the vineyard owner send last of all, to the cultivators, to get the fruits due to him?

25. So the Word became flesh and resided among us, and we had a view of his glory, a glory, such as belongs to an only-begotten son from a father, and he was full of undeserved

kindness and truth. (John 1:14)

[Question] What did the Word of God become, and what kind of a glory did he possess, and what filled him?

26. He that exercises faith in the Son, has everlasting life, he that disobeys the Son, will not see life, but the wrath of God remains upon him. (John 3:36)

[Question] What does the one exercising faith in the Son of God have within him?

[Question] What remains upon anyone, not exercising faith in Jesus Christ?

27. Most truly I say to you, he that hears my word and believes him that sent me, has everlasting life, and he does not come into judgment, but has passed over from death to life. (John 5:24)

[Question] What does the one hearing the word of the Good News and believing it, have within him, and what had such a one passed over from?

28. Hence Jesus said to them; Most truly I say to you, Moses did not give you the bread from heaven, but my Father does give you the true bread from heaven. (John 6:32)

[Question] Who did Jesus state, was like the manna given to the Israelites in the wilderness, but far better?

29. Most truly I say to you, he that believes, has everlasting life. (John 6:47)

[Question] What did Jesus state, that everyone believing in him has?

30" Jesus said to them; If God were your Father, you would love me, for from God I came forth and am here. Neither have I come of my own initiative at all, but that One sent me forth. (John 8:42)

[Question] What did Jesus state to the Jews, that considered Yehowah God as their spiritual Father?

31. But if anyone hears my sayings and does not keep them, I do not judge him, for I came, not to judge the world, but to save the world. (John 12:47)

[Question] What does believing in Jesus, also entail doing?

32. They said; Believe on the Lord Jesus and you will get saved, you and your household. (Acts of Apostles 16:31)

[Question] What did Paul tell the jailer in Thyatira, that he and his household must do to be saved?

33. To what end? That, just as sin ruled as king with death, likewise also, undeserved kindness might rule as king through righteousness, with everlasting life in view, through Jesus Christ our Lord. (Romans 5:21)

[Question] What ruled over mankind from Adam down to John the Baptist?

[Question] How does undeserved kindness now rule over mankind, and to what end?

34. But thanks to God, for he gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ! (1 Corinthians 15:57)

[Question] Why should anointed Christians be ever thankful to Yehowah God through Christ?

35. Paul, an apostle of Christ Jesus through God's will, according to the promise of the life, that is in union with Christ Jesus. (2 Timothy 1:1)

[Question] What promise comes to all those in union with Jesus Christ?

36. And after he had been made perfect, he became responsible for everlasting salvation, to all those obeying him. (Hebrews 5:9)

[Question] What did Jesus become responsible to God for, once he himself had been made perfect?

37. But my righteous one will live by reason of faith, and, if he shrinks back, my soul has no pleasure in him. (Hebrews 10:38)

[Question] How will Yehowah God's righteous ones keep living, and how does Yehowah God feel, if they shrink back, lacking faith?

38 By faith Abraham, when he was tested, as good as offered up Isaac, and the man that had gladly received the

promises, attempted to offer up his only-begotten son. (Hebrews 11:17)

[Question] How did Abraham respond to Yehowah God's requests, for what was he willing to offer up in faith?

39. See, what sort of love the Father has given us, so that we should be called children of God, and such we are. That is why, the world does not have a knowledge of us, because it has not come to know him. (1 John 3:1)

[Question] What are anointed Christians before their God?

[Question] Why does the world of mankind not understand anointed Christians?

40" By this we have come to know love, because that one surrendered his soul for us, and we are under obligation to surrender our souls for our brothers. (1 John 3:16)

[Question] How has the course of the Christ, taught true anointed Christians to love, and so what now is their obligation to God, and to one another?

41. And we ourselves have come to know and have believed, the love that God has in our case. God is love, and he that remains in love, remains in union with God, and God remains in union with him. (1 John 4:16)

[Question] What have anointed Christians come to believe about Yehowah God and his Christ?

[Question] What is God's primary quality, and what must anointed Christians remain in, to remain in union with Yehowah God?

42. To the only God our Savior through Jesus Christ our Lord, be glory, majesty, might and authority, for all past eternity, and now, and into all eternity. Amen. (Jude 1:25)

[Question] What belongs to Yehowah God eternally for doing thus with his Christ?
