John 3:17~ For God sent forth his Son into the world, not for him to judge the world, but for the world to be saved through him.

1. Yehowah God's great love for mankind is manifest in his sending forth of his son Jesus Christ, for he came forth not to judge mankind, but so that many in the world might be saved through him. His coming forth to mankind was a gesture of love and peace from a generous God.

[Question] How is Yehowah God's great love for mankind made manifest?

[Question] What is the coming forth of Jesus Christ, a gesture of toward mankind?

2. But if anyone hears my sayings and does not keep them, I do not judge him, for I came, not to judge the world, but to save the world. (John 12:47)

[Question] How does Jesus feel about ones who refuse to keep his commandments, for what was Jesus' purpose in coming into the world?

3. Namely, that God was by means of Christ, reconciling a world to himself, not reckoning to them their trespasses, and he committed the word of the reconciliation to us. (2 Corinthians 5:19)

[Question] What is Yehowah God doing respecting an alienated world of mankind, through Christ?

[Question] Who then, carry this message of reconciliation to all men?

4 For the Son of man came to seek and to save, what was lost. (Luke 19:10)

[Question] Why did the Son Of Man come to the earth?

5. For just as in Adam all are dying, so also in the Christ all will be made alive. (1 Corinthians 15:22)

[Question] What happens to all the offspring of Adam, the man?[Question] What happens to all the offspring of Jesus, the spirit?

6 Faithful, and deserving of full acceptance, is the saying, that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners. Of these, I am foremost. (1 Timothy 1:15)

[Question] What statement is deserving of full acceptance among men?

7. And he is a propitiatory sacrifice for our sins, yet not for ours only, but also for the whole world's. (1 John 2:2)

[Question] Who is Jesus an everlasting sacrifice for, and also who will later benefit from his sacrifice?

8. In addition, we ourselves have beheld and are bearing witness, that the Father has sent forth his Son, as Savior of the world. (1 John 4:14)

[Question] Why did Yehowah God send forth his son into the world?

9. You judge according to the flesh. I do not judge any man at all. (John 8:15)

[Question] How do men judge, yet did Jesus come to judge mankind, or what?

10" Has at the end of these days spoken to us by means of a Son, whom he appointed heir of all things, and through whom, he made the systems of things. (Hebrews 1:2)

[Question] Who has Yehowah God appointed, to become heir of all things with creation?

[Question] What role, has Jesus already played in the creation of all these things?

11. Consequently, holy brothers, partakers of the heavenly calling, consider the apostle and High Priest whom we confess, Jesus. (Hebrews 3:1)

[Question] Who does the apostle Paul encourage anointed Christians to consider closely?
