John 3:18~ He that exercises faith in him is not to be judged. He that does not exercise faith, has been judged already, because he has not exercised faith, in the name, of the only-begotten Son of God.

1 Jesus then showed, that the one that exercises faith in Christ, is not going to be judged, whereas the one not exercising faith has already been judged, because he has not exercised faith in the only-begotten Son of God.

[Question] What will not happen to anyone exercising faith in Jesus Christ?

[Question] What judgment though, remains upon anyone not exercising faith in Jesus Christ?

2. The Jews should have realized, that the Law Covenant did not bring about righteousness, but actually condemned them to death, through their sinfulness. No man had ever before lived up to all of the Law's requirements. Therefore, to reject God's mercy through his Son, left one in a condemned state in God's eyes.

[Question] What did the Law Covenant not bring about, for what did it actually do to men under it?

[Question] What then, was the situation of one rejecting the undeserved kindness of Yehowah God through his Christ?

3. Most truly I say to you, he that hears my word, and believes him that sent me, has everlasting life, and he does not come into judgment but has passed over from death to life. (John 5:24)

[Question] What does the one hearing and believing the word about the Christ obtain?

[Question] What does such a one escape from, that all others will experience, and what has such a one passed over from, and to?

4. Therefore those in union with Christ Jesus have no condemnation. (Romans 8:1)

[Question] What do those in union with Christ escape from?

5. But whoever disowns me before men, I will also disown him before my Father who is in the heavens. (Matthew 10:33) [Question] How will Jesus treat anyone, who disowns him before men?

6. Of how much more severe a punishment, do you think, will the man be counted worthy, who has trampled upon the Son of God, and who has esteemed as of ordinary value, the blood of the covenant by which he was sanctified, and who has outraged the spirit of undeserved kindness, with contempt? (Hebrews 10:29)

[Question] How will Yehowah God feel about anyone, who accepts his undeserved kindness through Christ, and then returns to a pathway of sinning?

7. Then concerning judgment, because the ruler of this world has been judged. (John 16:11)

[Question] How does the coming of the Christ, condemn Satan the Devil?

8. But when he again brings his Firstborn into the inhabited earth, he says; And let all God's angels do obeisance to him. (Hebrews 1:6)

[Question] How does Yehowah God want all his angels to view his firstborn son, Jesus Christ?
