Now this is the basis for judgment, that the light has come into the world, but men have loved the darkness rather than the light, for their works were wicked.

1. So then, Jesus showed Niocodemus, that the very basis for judgment, was that the true light, the Messiah, had come into the world, but the men he came to, loved the darkness rather than the light, for their works, and therefore their hearts, were wicked, and they refused to change, and come to repentance.

[Question] What did Jesus then show to Nicodemus, would become the basis for judgment from Yehowah God?

[Question] Why do men not want to follow after the teachings of the Christ?

2. The true light that gives light to every sort of man was about to come into the world. (John 1:9)

[Question] What true light did John the Baptist bear witness to, that was to come into the world, when he began his own ministry to Israel?

3. Therefore Jesus spoke again to them, saying; I am the light of the world. He that follows me will by no means walk in darkness, but will possess the light of life. (John 8:12)

[Question] What did Jesus tell men that he was while in the world?[Question] What then, would those following after him not walk in?

4. As long as I am in the world, I am the world's light. (John 9:5)

[Question] What was Jesus, while he was within the world of mankind?

5. I have come as a light into the world, in order, that everyone putting faith in me, may not remain in the darkness. (John 12:46)

[Question] Why did Jesus come forth as a light to the world of mankind, for what did he not want men to walk in any longer?

6. And the light is shining in the darkness, but the darkness has not overpowered it. (John 1:5)

[Question] Though he was a light within a world of darkness, would the darkness overpower his light?

[Question] What proves that down to this day?

7. As for them, they proved to be among the rebels against light, they did not recognize its ways, and they did not dwell in its roadways. (Job 24:13)

[Question] How did Job show that wicked men were rebels against divine light?

8' Woe to those who are saying, that good is bad, and bad is good, those who are putting darkness for light, and light for darkness, those who are putting bitter for sweet, and sweet for bitter! (Isaiah 5:20)

[Question] Who did Isaiah prophesy, that woe would come to, and why?

9. He that disregards me, and does not receive my sayings, has one to judge him. The word that I have spoken, is what will judge him in the last day. (John 12:48)

[Question] Who will judge all those, not putting faith in Jesus Christ?

10" Night they keep putting for day. Light is near on account of darkness. (Job 17:12)

[Question] What did Job state, that wicked men kept putting for day, and what did he mean by this statement?

11. And they say to the true God; Turn away from us! And in the knowledge of your ways we have found no delight.

(Job 21:14)

[Question] How do the wicked turn away from God, and from the doing of his will?

12. From those leaving the paths of uprightness to walk in the ways of darkness. (Proverbs 2:13)

[Question] What ways do those leaving Yehowah walk in, since he is the God of spiritual enlightenment?

13. But the one missing me is doing violence to his soul. All those intensely hating me, are the ones that do love death. (Proverbs 8:36)

[Question] What does the man not following Yehowah God do to his own soul, and what do such ones love who hate Yehowah God?

14. As regards anyone wise, his eyes are in his head, but the stupid one is walking on in sheer darkness. And I have come to know, I too, that there is one eventuality, that eventuates to them all. (Ecclesiastes 2:14)

[Question] What is the stupid one walking in?

15. The prophets themselves actually prophesy in falsehood, and as for the priests, they go subduing according to their powers. And my own people have loved it that way, and what will you men do in the finale of it? (Jeremiah 5:31)

[Question] How did Jeremiah testify about how the false prophets walked and prophesied?

16. And he proceeded to say to me; Have you seen, O son of man, what the elderly ones of the house of Israel are doing in the darkness, each one in the inner rooms of his showpiece? For they are saying; Yehowah is not seeing us. Yehowah has left the land. (Ezekiel 8:12)

[Question] What was Ezekiel shown about the older men of Israel, and what they were doing in private, that they thought that Yehowah did not know about?

17. You are the light of the world. A city cannot be hid when situated upon a mountain. (Matthew 5:14)

[Question] What did Jesus tell his disciples that they were within the world?

18. The world has no reason to hate you, but it hates me, because I bear witness concerning it that its works are wicked. (John 7:7)

[Question] Why did the world of Jesus' day come to hate him?

19. And Jesus said; For this judgment I came into this world. That those not seeing, might see, and those seeing, might become blind. (John 9:39)

[Question] For what judgment did Jesus Christ come into the world of mankind?

20" In a flaming fire, as he brings vengeance upon those who do not know God, and those who do not obey the Good News, about our Lord Jesus. (2 Thessalonians 1:8)

[Question] What will Christ bring upon those, who do not know Yehowah God, or who do not obey the Good News, when he comes in judgment?

21. For her sins have massed together clear up to heaven, and God has called her acts of injustice to mind. (Revelation 18:5)

[Question] Whose sins have massed together right up to heaven, and who has called her acts of injustice to mind?
