

John 3:26~ So they came to John and said to him; Rabbi, the man that was with you across the Jordan, to whom you have borne witness, see, this one is baptizing, and all are going to him.

1· So these ones came forth to John the Baptist and said to him, that all who had once followed him, were now going to Jesus, the one that he had borne witness to, and that Jesus was also baptizing people, and all were now going to him.

[Question] What did John the Baptist's disciples express concern to John over?

2· This man came for a witness, in order to bear witness about the light, that people of all sorts might believe through him. (John 1:7)

[Question] What did Jesus' disciple John, state about John the Baptist in his gospel?

3· And I have seen it, and I have borne witness, that this one is the Son of God. (John 1:34)

[Question] What did John the Baptist bear witness to, toward many, after seeing the Holy Spirit come down upon Jesus?

4· So he went on to say; This is why I have said to you, no one can come to me, unless it is granted him by the Father. (John 6:65)

[Question] Who only can come to the Father?

5· Now John's disciples reported to him about all these things. (Luke 7:18)

[Question] What then, did John the Baptist's disciples report to him about?

6· After these things Jesus and his disciples went into Judean country, and there he spent some time with them, and did baptizing. (John 3:22)

[Question] What did Jesus and his disciples do, after leaving Jerusalem, and where did they do this?

7· Therefore the Pharisees said among themselves; You observe you are getting absolutely nowhere. See! The

world has gone after him. (John 12:19)

[Question] What did the Pharisees say and feel, when seeing all their previous supporters go to Jesus?
