In answer Jesus said to him; Most truly I say to you, unless anyone is born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God.

Footnote: Is born again Literally, should be generated from above Greek, $gen \cdot ne \cdot thei'$ a'no $\cdot then$

1. Then Jesus told Nicodemus, that unless anyone was born again, that he could not see the Kingdom of God.

[Question] What then, did Jesus tell Nicodemus, that everyone must experience, before they could enter the Kingdom of God?

2. You have made life's ways known to me, you will fill me with good cheer with your face. (Acts of Apostles 2:28)

[Question] What scripture did Peter later quote, regarding Jesus?

3. And they were born, not from blood, or from a fleshly will, or from man's will, but from God. (John 1:13)

[Question] By means of whose will, are anointed Christians born to spiritual life, their own, or God's will?

4 Consequently, if anyone is in union with Christ, he is a new creation, the old things passed away, look! New things have come into existence. (2 Corinthians 5:17)

[Question] What is anyone, who is truly in union with Christ?

5. For neither is circumcision anything nor is uncircumcision, but a new creation is something. (Galatians 6:15)

[Question] How important relatively, is the spiritual rebirth, in relation to circumcision?

6. Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, for according to his great mercy he gave us a new birth to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead. (1 Peter 1:3)

[Question] Who gives anointed Christians a rebirth spiritually, and to what kind of a hope?

7. For you have been given a new birth, not by corruptible, but by incorruptible reproductive seed, through the word of the living and enduring God. (1 Peter 1:23)

[Question] What kind of seed, thus gives anointed Christians a new birth?

- 8. Everyone who has been born from God does not carry on sin, because His reproductive seed remains in such one, and he cannot practice sin, because he has been born from God. (1 John 3:9)
 - [Question] What do those who have been born from Yehowah God, not carry on any longer, for whose seed is within them henceforth?
- 9. However, this I say, brothers, that flesh and blood cannot inherit God's kingdom, neither does corruption inherit incorruption. (1 Corinthians 15:50)
 - [Question] What cannot inherit God's Kingdom?
- 10" Truly I say to you people, among those born of women there has not been raised up a greater than John the Baptist, but a person that is a lesser one in the kingdom of the heavens is greater than he is. (Matthew 11:11)

[Question] Who was John the Baptist greater than, yet how important relative to him, is anyone receiving the spirit anointing from Yehowah God?
