John 3:33~ He that has accepted his witness has put his seal to it, that God is true.

1. Also the one accepting the witness about the Christ, has placed his own seal upon it, that God is true.

[Question] What does the one accepting Jesus' witness, put a seal to in his own heart?

2. Never may that happen! But let God be found true, though every man be found a liar, even as it is written: That you might be proved righteous in your words, and might win when you are being judged. (Romans 3:4)

[Question] Who did Paul feel should be found true, no matter what men thought?

3. The person putting his faith in the Son of God, has the witness given in his own case. The person not having faith in God has made him a liar, because he has not put his faith in the witness given, which God, as witness, has given concerning his Son. (1 John 5:10)

[Question] What witness does Yehowah God give to the man putting faith in his son, Jesus Christ?

[Question] What does the man not putting his faith in Jesus, call God?

4. There are seventy weeks that have been determined upon your people and upon your holy city, in order to terminate the transgression, and to finish off sin, and to make atonement for error, and to bring in righteousness for times indefinite, and to imprint a seal upon vision and prophet, and to anoint the Holy of Holies. (Daniel 9:24)

[Question] What was to happen to sin, at the end of the seventy weeks of years when the Messiah came forth?
