

John 3:34~ For the one whom God sent forth speaks the sayings of God, for he does not give the spirit by measure.¹

Footnote: Or, sparingly

1· John the Baptist then showed, that the one that God sent forth to witness to mankind, spoke the true sayings of God, for God did not measure out a stingy portion of the spirit to him.

[Question] What did John the Baptist then show, that Jesus spoke before men, for how does Yehowah God give the Holy Spirit?

2· Therefore the Jews began looking for him at the festival and saying; Where is that man? (John 7:11)

[Question] How did Jesus go up to one of the festivals of the Jews, and why?

3· For we all received from out of his fullness, even undeserved kindness upon undeserved kindness. (John 1:16)

[Question] How do anointed Christians gain undeserved kindness from Yehowah God?

4· And he went on to say to me; Son of man, all my words that I shall speak to you, take into your heart and hear with your own ears. (Ezekiel 3:10)

[Question] What was the Son Of Man told to take and keep close to his heart?

5· Jesus, in turn, answered them and said; What I teach is not mine, but belongs to him that sent me. (John 7:16)

[Question] What did Jesus testify, about the things he himself taught?

6· Also, I know that his commandment means everlasting life. Therefore the things I speak, just as the Father has told me them, so I speak them. (John 12:50)

[Question] Why did Jesus courageously speak the things of God, for what do they mean for men?

[Question] Where did Jesus obtain these sayings of everlasting life?

7· And he tells me; Write! Happy are those invited to the

evening meal of the Lamb's marriage. Also, he tells me; These are the true sayings of God. (Revelation 19:9)

[Question] What does the Revelation account state about anyone invited to the Lamb's marriage?
