John 3:35~ The Father loves the Son, and has given all things into his hand.

1. John the Baptist then showed, that the father loves his own Son, and thus has given all things into his hands.

[Question] Why had the Father given all things into the hands of his favorite son?

2. For the Father has affection for the Son, and shows him all the things he himself does, and he will show him works greater than these, in order, that you may marvel. (John 5:20)

[Question] How does the Father show his deep affection for the son, and what will he show him in the future?

3. Just as the Father has loved me, and I have loved you, remain in my love. (John 15:9)

[Question] How should anointed Christians remain in Jesus Christ's love?

4. All things have been delivered to me by my Father, and no one fully knows the Son, but the Father, neither does anyone fully know the Father, but the Son, and anyone to whom the Son is willing to reveal him. (Matthew 11:27)

[Question] What things have been delivered to Jesus Christ by Yehowah God, and who knows his son the best?

[Question] Who also knows the Father the very best?

5. And Jesus approached and spoke to them, saying; All authority has been given me in heaven and on the earth. (Matthew 28:18)

[Question] What did Jesus tell his disciples just before ascending to heaven to the Father?

6. All things have been delivered to me by my Father, and who the Son is no one knows, but the Father, and who the Father is, no one knows, but the Son, and he, to whom the Son is willing to reveal him. (Luke 10:22)

[Question] How close and intimate is the relationship be Yehowah God and Jesus Christ?

7. According as you have given him authority over all flesh, that, as regards the whole number whom you have given him, he may give them everlasting life. (John 17:2)

[Question] What authority did Yehowah God give to Jesus Christ respecting his anointed Christian disciples?

8. The way of the wicked one is something detestable to Yehowah, but the one pursuing righteousness, he loves. (Proverbs 15:9)

[Question] Whose way is something detestable to Yehowah God, but whom does Yehowah God love?

9. And to him there were given rulership and dignity and kingdom, that the peoples, national groups and languages, should all serve even him. His rulership is an indefinitely lasting rulership, that will not pass away, and his kingdom one, that will not be brought to ruin. (Daniel 7:14)

[Question] What are given to the Son Of Man in the vision of Daniel, and how long will his rulership last for?

10" In order, that all may honor the Son, just as they honor the Father. He that does not honor the Son, does not honor the Father who sent him. (John 5:23)

[Question] How should men treat the son, and why?

[Question] Can anyone dishonoring the Son, also love the Father?

11. All the things that the Father has are mine. That is why I said, he receives from what is mine, and declares it to you. (John 16:15)

[Question] Who is the inheritor of all things of this creation?

[Question] What things then, would the Holy Spirit make known to Jesus' disciples?

12. Therefore let all the house of Israel know for a certainty, that God made him both Lord and Christ, this Jesus, whom you impaled. (Acts of Apostles 2:36)

[Question] What must all the house of Israel know for a certainty, as Peter witnessed to, at Pentecost?

13. But when all things will have been subjected to him, then

the Son himself will also subject himself, to the One who subjected all things to him, that God may be all things to everyone. (1 Corinthians 15:28)

[Question] Who will Jesus Christ subject himself to, when all other things have been subjected to himself, and to what end?

14. In praise of his glorious undeserved kindness, which he kindly conferred upon us, by means of his loved one. (Ephesians 1:6)

[Question] How did Yehowah God confer his glorious undeserved kindness upon men?
