

John 3:36~ He that exercises faith in the Son has everlasting life, he that disobeys the Son will not see life, but the wrath of God remains upon him.

- 1· So John the Baptist showed, that he that exercised faith in the son of God would have everlasting life, and conversely, he that would disobey the son would not see life, for the wrath of God remained upon such a one.

[Question] What did John the Baptist show, that anyone exercising faith in the son of God, would have?

[Question] Conversely, what does the one not exercising faith, have remain upon him?

- 2· Look! His soul **has** been swelled up, it **has** not been upright within him. But as for the righteous one, by his faithfulness he **will** keep living. (**Habakkuk 2:4**)

[Question] How will the righteous one keep living?

- 3· For in it, God's righteousness is being revealed by reason of **faith**, and toward **faith**, just as it is written: But the righteous one, by means of **faith** he **will** live. (**Romans 1:17**)

[Question] By means of what will the righteous ones keep living?

- 4· For **God** loved the world so much, that he gave his only-begotten **Son**, in order, that everyone exercising **faith** in him, might not be destroyed, but have **everlasting life**. (**John 3:16**)

[Question] How did Yehowah God show his great love for mankind, and to what end purpose?

- 5· Most truly I say to you, he that believes, **has everlasting life**. (**John 6:47**)

[Question] What did Jesus Christ state, that anyone exercising faith in him would receive?

- 6· And after he had been made perfect, he became responsible for **everlasting** salvation, to all those obeying him. (**Hebrews 5:9**)

[Question] What is Jesus responsible for, and toward whom?

- 7· In a flaming fire, as he brings vengeance upon those who do not know **God**, and those who do not obey the Good News about our Lord Jesus. (**2 Thessalonians 1:8**)

[Question] Who will Christ bring God's vengeance upon, when, and why?

- 8· He that **has the Son, has this life**, he that does not have the **Son of God, does not have this life**. (**1 John 5:12**)

[Question] What does anyone having the Son also have, and what does anyone not having the Son, lack?

- 9· However, for those who are contentious, and who disobey the truth, but obey unrighteousness, there **will be wrath and anger**. (**Romans 2:8**)

[Question] What remains for people who are contentious and disobey the truth, and do unrighteousness?

- 10· Let no man deceive you with empty words, for because of the aforesaid things, the **wrath of God** is coming upon the sons of disobedience. (**Ephesians 5:6**)

[Question] What should we not let anyone deceive us about, for what is certainly coming upon the sons of disobedience?

- 11· But there is a certain fearful expectation of judgment and there is a fiery jealousy, that is going to consume those in opposition. (**Hebrews 10:27**)

[Question] What remain for people who refuse to turn around in repentance and do God's will?

- 12· Kiss the son, that He may not become incensed, and you may not perish from the way, for his anger flares up easily. Happy are all those taking refuge in him. (**Psalms 2:12**)

[Question] How are the rulers of this system of things counseled to act toward the Son Of Man, and why?

[Question] What will all those taking refuge in Jesus Christ experience?

- 13· For the one finding me **will** certainly find **life**, and gets goodwill from Yehowah. (**Proverbs 8:35**)

[Question] What will the one finding Yehowah God find, and what will he receive from Yehowah God?

- 14· That everyone believing in him, may have everlasting life. (John 3:15)**

[Question] What does everyone believing in Jesus Christ receive?

- 15· Yes, among them we all at one time conducted ourselves in harmony with the desires of our flesh, doing the things willed by the flesh, and the thoughts, and we were naturally children of wrath, even as the rest. (Ephesians 2:3)**

[Question] What were anointed Christians doing before becoming anointed Christians, and so what were they children of then?

- 16· We know we have passed over from death to life, because we love the brothers. He who does not love remains in death. (1 John 3:14)**

[Question] What does our love for the brothers prove about us?

[Question] Where does the one not loving others remain?
