

John 3:5~ **Jesus answered; Most truly I say to you, unless anyone is born from water and spirit,¹ he cannot enter into the kingdom of God.**

1· So Jesus attempted to explain to Nicodemus that this second birth was a different kind of birth. The birth that humans normally undergo is from water, for when the water sac surrounding the baby breaks then the time of birth follows immediately. Yet anyone entering into the Kingdom of God must also undergo a second birth through the spirit of God. Only those experiencing both births could then enter into the Kingdom of God. [See Also Revealing The Sons Of God Chapter 4]

[Question] What then, did Jesus try to help Nicodemus to understand?

[Question] What is the normal human manner of birth, and what do they come through, during this birth?

[Question] What did Jesus then contrast to this normal way of human birth?

[Question] Who alone then, would enter into the Kingdom of God, and who give this birth alone?

2· Go therefore and make disciples of people of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. (Matthew 28:19)

[Question] What commission did Jesus give his disciples, to do in his absence?

3· Now as they were going over the road, they came to a certain body of water, and the eunuch said; Look! A body of water. What prevents me from getting baptized? (Acts of Apostles 8:36)

[Question] How did a certain Ethiopian eunuch feel, upon hearing the witness of the Good News of God's Kingdom, and so what did he want to do immediately?

4· Can anyone forbid water so that these might not be baptized who have received the Holy Spirit even as we have? (Acts of Apostles 10:47)

[Question] What did Peter express, when he saw the manifestation of the Holy Spirit fall upon the household of Cornelius?

- 5· **On hearing this, they got baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus. (Acts of Apostles 19:5)**

[Question] What did men do, after hearing the witness about the Christ?

- 6· **I, for my part, baptize you with **water**, because of your repentance, but the one coming after me is stronger than I am, whose sandals I am not fit to take off. That one will baptize you people with Holy Spirit and with fire. (Matthew 3:11)**

[Question] What did John the Baptist baptize with, and what did he state about the one coming after him, and how he would baptize?

- 7· **Even I did not know him, but the very One who sent me to baptize in **water** said to me; Whoever it is upon whom you see the **spirit** coming down and remaining, this is the one that baptizes in Holy Spirit. (John 1:33)**

[Question] How did John the Baptist witness to seeing the one who baptizes with Holy Spirit?

- 8· **Because John, indeed, baptized with **water**, but you will be baptized in Holy Spirit not many days after this. (Acts of Apostles 1:5)**

[Question] What did Jesus tell his disciples shortly before leaving the earth the final time?

- 9· **And the faithful ones that had come with Peter who were of those circumcised were amazed, because the free gift of the Holy Spirit was being poured out also upon people of the nations. (Acts of Apostles 10:45)**

[Question] How did the men accompanying Peter feel, when they saw the Holy Spirit poured out upon Gentiles?

- 10· **At this I called to mind the saying of the Lord, how he used to **say**, John, for his part, baptized with **water**, but you will be baptized in Holy Spirit. (Acts of Apostles 11:16)**

[Question] Whose saying did Peter call to mind, when he saw the Holy Spirit fall upon Cornelius and his household?

- 11· And when Paul laid his hands upon them, the Holy Spirit came upon them, and they began speaking with tongues and prophesying. (**Acts of Apostles 19:6**)

[Question] What happened to Apollos, when he first heard the witness about the Christ, for what had he not yet received at that time?

- 12· For **truly** by one **spirit** we were all baptized into one body, whether Jews or Greeks, whether slaves or free, and we were all made to drink one **spirit**. (**1 Corinthians 12:13**)

[Question] What one spirit are all anointed with, and what are all anointed Christians baptized into?

- 13· For I **say** to you, that if your righteousness does not abound more than that of the scribes and Pharisees, you will by no means **enter** into the **kingdom** of the heavens. (**Matthew 5:20**)

[Question] What did Jesus tell the self-righteous scribes and Pharisees, about the possibility of them entering the Kingdom of God?

- 14· For all who are led by God's **spirit**, these are God's sons. (**Romans 8:14**)

[Question] Who are truly God's anointed sons?

- 15· Owing to no works in righteousness that we had performed, but according to his mercy he saved us through the bath that brought us to life, and through the making of us new by Holy Spirit. (**Titus 3:5**)

[Question] What bath in what, brings anointed Christians to life in the spirit?

- 16· In general assembly, and the congregation of the firstborn who have been enrolled in the heavens, and **God**, the Judge of all, and the spiritual lives of righteous ones, who have been made perfect. (**Hebrews 12:23**)

[Question] Where are the lives of faithful anointed Christians enrolled now?

[Question] How does the Holy Spirit provide the impetus, to make anointed Christians perfect before Yehowah God?

- 17· In fact, thus there will be richly supplied to you the

entrance into the everlasting kingdom of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. (2 Peter 1:11)

[Question] What does the spirit anointing give one entrance into, and who alone can this come forth from?
