3· After that Yehowah said; My **spirit** shall not act toward man indefinitely, in that he is also **flesh**. Accordingly his days shall amount to a hundred and twenty years. (Genesis 6:3)

[Question] What is mankind?

4· Who can produce someone clean out of someone unclean? There is not one. (Job 14:4)

[Question] Is it possible to produce someone clean, out of someone unclean?

5· For those who are in accord with the **flesh** set their minds on the things of the **flesh**, but those in accord with the **spirit** on the things of the **spirit**. (Romans 8:5)

[Question] What do those who live in accord with the flesh, set their minds upon?

[Question] What do those in accord with the Holy Spirit, set their minds upon?

6· For you have been given a new birth, not by corruptible, but by incorruptible reproductive seed, through the word of the living and enduring God. (1 Peter 1:23)

[Question] What have anointed Christians been given, and through what kind of reproductive seed?
