The wind blows where it wants to, and you hear the sound of it, but you do not know where it comes from and where it is going. So is everyone, that has been born from the spirit.¹

Jesus then illustrated how the spirit works, by comparing it to the wind. Now men can hear the wind blowing and moving through objects, but they have no idea where it comes from, or where it is going to. Then Jesus told Nicodemus, that the spirit works just like this. It could enter into men unseen, and men would not fully understand what it was about.

[Question] How did Jesus then illustrate, how this spirit works within true anointed Christians?

[Question] How does the spirit enter into men, is it seen, or its purpose revealed?

2. Just as you are not aware of what is the way of the spirit in the bones in the belly of her that is pregnant, in like manner you do not know the work of the true God, who does all things. (Ecclesiastes 11:5)

[Question] What are men even today not fully aware of, though they know it exists?

3. The spirit of the truth, which the world cannot receive, because it neither beholds it nor knows it. You know it, because it remains with you and is in you. (John 14:17)

[Question] How is this spirit denoted as being, and who cannot know it, and its operation?

[Question] Why though, do anointed Christians know it intimately?

4. And suddenly there occurred from heaven a noise, just like that of a rushing stiff breeze, and it filled the whole house in which they were sitting. (Acts of Apostles 2:2)

[Question] What noise was heard at Pentecost, and how did it affect those there?

5. The spirit itself bears witness with our spirit, that we are God's children. (Romans 8:16)

[Question] What tells anointed Christians, that they are God's children?

6. For who among men knows the things of a man except the spirit of man that is in him? So, too, no one has come to know the things of God, except the spirit of God. (1 Corinthians 2:11)

[Question] What is most intimately aware of the feelings within a man?

[Question] How then, do anointed Christians come to know Yehowah God, for what spirit does he put within them?

7. The wind is going to the south, and it is circling around to the north. Round and round it is continually circling, and right back to its circlings the wind is returning.

(Ecclesiastes 1:6)

[Question] How did the congregator show, how the weather works centuries before men understood it?

8. Sanctify a time of fasting. Call together a solemn assembly. Gather together the older men, all the inhabitants of the land, to the house of Yehowah your God, and cry to Yehowah for aid. (Joel 1:14)

[Question] What did Joel call for the people of Israel to do, to search for their God?

9. For all who are led by God's spirit, these are God's sons. (Romans 8:14)

[Question] Who today, are God's true anointed Christian sons?

10. After this I saw four angels standing upon the four corners of the earth, holding tight the four winds of the earth, that no wind might blow upon the earth, or upon the sea, or upon any tree. (Revelation 7:1)

[Question] What work must be held back, until what calling is complete?
