John 4:10~ In answer Jesus said to her; If you had known the free gift of God, and who it is that says to you; Give me a drink. You would have asked him, and he would have given you living water.

1. In answer Jesus said to her, that if she had known who it was that asked her for a drink, and known about the free gift of God he was carrying within him, that she would have asked him for a drink and he would have given her living water.

[Question] What did Jesus tell this woman, that she would have done if she knew who she was talking to?

2' By this undeserved kindness, indeed, you have been saved through faith, and this not owing to you, it is God's gift. (Ephesians 2:8)

**[Question]** How does the gift of life come to spirit anointed Christians?

3. For there has been a child born to us, there has been a son given to us. The princely rule will come to be upon his shoulder. His name will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Eternal Father, Prince of Peace. (Isaiah 9:6)

[Question] Who was prophesied to come forth to Israel, and what would come to be upon his shoulder?

[Question] What roles would this one later fill in behalf of Yehowah God's people?

4. Jesus said to her; I who am speaking to you, am he. (John 4:26)

[Question] What did Jesus later plainly tell this woman, about who he was?

5. With exultation you people will be certain to draw water out of the springs of salvation. (Isaiah 12:3)

[Question] How did the prophecy of Isaiah have a fulfillment toward this woman, as she drew water from the well for Jesus, and he witnessed to her?

6 Because there are two bad things that my people have done, They have left even me, the source of living water, in order to hew out for themselves cisterns, broken cisterns, that cannot contain the water. (Jeremiah 2:13)

[Question] What does Yehowah God speak of himself as being toward Israel?

[Question] Why was their failure to hold firmly to the truth, like storing Yehowah's water of truth in broken cisterns or jars that leaked?

7. In that day there will come to be a well opened to the house of David, and to the inhabitants of Jerusalem, for sin, and for an abhorrent thing. (Zechariah 13:1)

[Question] What did Zechariah promise was coming for Jerusalem and her peoples, and what then would happen to sin?

8. And it must occur in that day, that living waters will go forth from Jerusalem, half of them to the eastern sea, and half of them to the western sea. In summer and in winter it will occur. (Zechariah 14:8)

[Question] What did Zechariah also prophesy about living waters that would come forth in the future?

9. Now on the last day, the great day of the festival, Jesus was standing up, and he cried out, saying; If anyone is thirsty, let him come to me and drink. (John 7:37)

[Question] What did Jesus cry out to all the people of Israel on the great day of the festival in Jerusalem, for what were the truths he bore like to the people?

10" And all drank the same spiritual drink. For they used to drink from the spiritual rock-mass that followed them, and that rock-mass meant the Christ. (1 Corinthians 10:4)

[Question] How did Paul identify who it was that watered the nation of Israel in their wilderness wanderings?

11. And he showed me a river of water of life, clear as crystal, flowing out from the throne of God, and of the Lamb. (Revelation 22:1)

[Question] What is shown in Revelation to water God's people, and where does it emanate from?
