John 4:12~ You are not greater than our forefather Jacob, who gave us the well and who himself together with his sons and his cattle drank out of it, are you?

1. Then she asked Jesus, if he was greater than their forefather Jacob, who had given them the well, and who himself, along with his sons, used to drink from it.

[Question] What then, did she relate about the well, and who originally made it, and drank from it?

2. Men of Nineveh will rise up in the judgment with this generation, and will condemn it, because they repented at what Jonah preached, but, look! Something more than Jonah is here. (Matthew 12:41)

[Question] What did Jesus tell the Israelites, that men of Nineveh would do on judgment day, respecting them?

[Question] Was Jesus a prophet greater than Jonah?

3. The queen of the south will be raised up in the judgment with the men of this generation and will condemn them. Because she came from the ends of the earth to hear the wisdom of Solomon, but, look! Something more than Solomon is here. (Luke 11:31)

[Question] How did Jesus show how the Queen of Sheba would feel when judgment day came, and why so?

[Question] Was Jesus Christ greater than Solomon?

4' You are not greater than our father Abraham, who died, are you? Also, the prophets died. Who do you claim to be? (John 8:53)

[Question] What did the Jews think Jesus was not greater than, who had come before him?

5. In fact, Jacob's fountain was there. Now Jesus, tired out from the journey, was sitting at the fountain just as he was. The hour was about the sixth. (John 4:6)

[Question] Who made the fountain or well that Jesus then drank from, and what time of day was this?
