

John 4:20~

Our forefathers worshiped in this mountain, but you people say that in Jerusalem is the place where persons ought to worship.

1· So the woman told Jesus, that her people had worshiped in the mountain in Samaria, but that the Jews said, that the only true place to worship, was at the temple in Jerusalem. Jerusalem was in fact the place Yehowah God had designated for his true worship to take place, and where he had placed his glorious name.

[Question] What did the woman ask questioningly of Jesus, about where worship ought to be conducted?

[Question] Where was the place then, of true worship, the only one approved by Yehowah God?

2· And it must occur that when Yehowah your God brings you into the land to which you are going to take possession of it, you must also give the blessing upon Mount Gerizim, and the malediction upon Mount Ebal. (Deuteronomy 11:29)

[Question] Where did the Israelites stand before their God, and recite the blessing and the malediction?

3· But to the place that Yehowah your God will choose, out of all your tribes, to place his name there, to have it reside, you will seek, and there you must come. (Deuteronomy 12:5)

[Question] What did Moses tell the Israelites, that Yehowah God would select for them to worship in?

4· And Yehowah went on to say to him; I have heard your prayer and your request for favor, with which you requested favor before me. I have sanctified this house, that you have built, by putting my name there to time indefinite, and my eyes and my heart will certainly prove to be there, always. (1 Kings 9:3)

[Question] How did Yehowah God answer the prayer of Solomon at the temple dedication, and how did that establish the place of true worship for all Israel?

5· Yehowah now appeared to Solomon during the night, and said to him; I have heard your prayer, and I have chosen this place for myself, as a house of sacrifice. (2 Chronicles

7:12)

[Question] What did Yehowah God reveal to Solomon in a vision of the night?

6· I rejoiced when they were saying to me; To the house of Yehowah let us go. (Psalms 122:1)

[Question] Who did the Psalmist feel when going forth to worship in Jerusalem?

7· Our feet, proved to be standing within your gates, O Jerusalem. (Psalms 122:2)

[Question] How did the Psalmist identify where true worship was conducted?

8· Jerusalem is one that is built like a city, that has been joined together in oneness. (Psalms 122:3)

[Question] How did the city of Jerusalem, and one way of worship, unify Israel, when they practiced it faithfully?

9· To which the tribes have gone up, the tribes of Yah, as a reminder to Israel to give thanks to the name of Yehowah. (Psalms 122:4)

[Question] Where did the tribes of Israel go up to three times a year to worship and give thanks?

10· For there the thrones for judgment have been sitting, thrones for the house of David. (Psalms 122:5)

[Question] Whose house of rulership did Yehowah God also set up there in Jerusalem?

11· Ask, O you people, for the peace of Jerusalem. Those loving you, O city, will be free from care. (Psalms 122:6)

[Question] What were God's people told to ask for toward Jerusalem?

[Question] Who would those loving Jerusalem fare?

12· May peace continue within your rampart, freedom from care within your dwelling towers. (Psalms 122:7)

[Question] What did the Psalmist ask, to continue within Jerusalem?

13· For the sake of my brothers and my companions, I will now

speaking; **May there be peace within you. (Psalms 122:8)**

[Question] What did the Psalmist ask for within Jerusalem?

14 **For the sake of the house of Yehowah our God I will keep seeking good for you. (Psalms 122:9)**

[Question] How did the Psalmist feel about Yehowah God's house?
