John 4:22~ You worship, what you do not know, we worship, what we know, because salvation originates with the Jews.

1. Then he told her that as a Samaritan, she worshiped what she did not know, for their way of worship was instituted by men, first under wicked king Jeroboam, with a man appointed way of worship, and priesthood, and with idol worship. The Jews on the other hand had remained true to the way of worship that God instituted from the time of Moses and forward, with its true God appointed priesthood and temple.

[Question] Why did Jesus tell the woman, that she worshiped what she did not know?

[Question] Why was the worship of the Jews different, and God approved?

2. However, each different nation came to be a maker of its own god, which they then deposited in the house of the high places that the Samaritans had made, each different nation, in their cities where they were dwelling. (2 Kings 17:29)

[Question] How did the Samaritans allow every kind of religious error to become part of their religion, and who today is like them?

3. It was of Yehowah that they became fearers, but it was of their own gods that they proved to be worshipers, according to the religion of the nations, from among whom they had led them into exile. (2 Kings 17:33)

[Question] Who did the Jews fear, yet still who did they worship, and whose religion did they adopt and pervert true worship with?

4. And many peoples will certainly go and say; Come, you people, and let us go up to the mountain of Yehowah, to the house of the God of Jacob, and he will instruct us about his ways, and we will walk in his paths. For out of Zion Law will go forth, and the word of Yehowah out of Jerusalem. (Isaiah 2:3)

[Question] What did Isaiah prophesy would happen in the final part of the days with true worship, and what would people then seek out?

5. Who, as such, are Israelites, to whom belong the adoption as sons and the glory and the covenants, and the giving of

the Law, and the sacred service, and the promises. (Romans 9:4)

[Question] To whom did the covenants and promises of Yehowah God rightfully belong, if they had kept them?

6 Accordingly one of the priests whom they had led into exile from Samaria, came, and began dwelling in Bethel, and he came to be a teacher of them, as to how they ought to fear Yehowah. (2 Kings 17:28)

[Question] What did one of the priests from Samaria come to Judah and do there?

7 However, Zerubbabel and Jeshua and the rest of the heads of the paternal houses of Israel said to them; You have nothing to do with us in building a house to our God, for we ourselves shall together build to Yehowah the God of Israel, just as King Cyrus the king of Persia has commanded us. (Ezra 4:3)

[Question] How did those rebuilding the temple, exclude others from participation, and why?

8. Woe to those drawing error with ropes of untruth, and as with wagon cords sin. (Isaiah 5:18)

[Question] What was the worship of the people of Samaria, likened to by Isaiah?

9. Truly the hills as well as the turmoil on the mountains, belong to falsehood. Truly, in Yehowah our God, is the salvation of Israel. (Jeremiah 3:23)

[Question] How did Jeremiah show, that men of Samaria would look to human governments to bring them salvation, which was a falsehood?

10. What, then, is the superiority of the Jew, or what is the benefit of the circumcision? (Romans 3:1)

[Question] What did Paul ask about the superiority of the Jew, in approaching Yehowah God?

11. Beloved ones, though I was making every effort to write you, about the salvation we hold in common, I found it necessary to write you, to exhort you, to put up a hard fight for the faith, that was once for all time delivered to the holy ones. (Jude 1:3)

[Question] What did Jude find it necessary to write to his anointed Christian brothers about, for what later crept into Christianity also?
