Nevertheless, the hour is coming, and it is now, when the true worshipers will worship the Father with spirit and truth, for, indeed, the Father is looking for suchlike ones to worship him.

1. Then Jesus showed, that nonetheless, the hour was coming and it was now, when true worshippers would worship the father, Yehowah God, with spirit and with truth. Indeed, Yehowah God was looking for such ones to worship him. Then also, the distinctions of Samaritan and Jew, would simply disappear.

[Question] What hour though, did Jesus state was coming, and in fact was present?

[Question] What kind of men does Yehowah God want to worship him, and how must he be worshiped, to be acceptable before him?

[Question] What then, would soon happen to the prior distinctions as Jews and Samaritans, Greeks and Babylonians?

2. The spirit of the truth, which the world cannot receive, because it neither beholds it, nor knows it. You know it, because it remains with you, and is in you. (John 14:17)

[Question] What spirit remains within anointed Christians, and where does it come forth from?

3. That the righteous requirement of the Law might be fulfilled in us who walk, not in accord with the flesh, but in accord with the spirit. (Romans 8:4)

[Question] Who come to actually fulfill the Law Covenant by fine conduct, and what motivates this fine conduct among anointed Christians?

4. While we keep our eyes, not on the things seen, but on the things unseen. For the things seen are temporary, but the things unseen are everlasting. (2 Corinthians 4:18)

[Question] What thing must anointed Christians keep focused upon, and why?

5. For we are walking by faith, not by sight. (2 Corinthians 5:7)

[Question] Are anointed Christians walking toward something they can see, or something that they have faith in?

6. For we are those with the real circumcision, who are rendering sacred service by God's spirit, and have our boasting in Christ Jesus, and do not have our confidence in the flesh. (Philippians 3:3)

[Question] How did anointed Christians render to God sacred service, and what is their confidence in?

7. And now fear Yehowah, and serve him in faultlessness and in truth, and remove the gods that your forefathers served on the other side of the River, and in Egypt, and serve Yehowah. (Joshua 24:14)

[Question] What did Joshua tell the Israelites to walk in, and what things were they to remove to practice true worship?

8. Only fear Yehowah, and you must serve him in truth, with all your heart, for see what great things he has done for you. (1 Samuel 12:24)

[Question] How must all serve Yehowah God, the God of truth?

9. Make me walk in your truth and teach me, for you are my God of salvation. In you I have hoped all day long. (Psalms 25:5)

[Question] What did the Psalmist ask Yehowah God to make him walk in daily, and why?

10" Instruct me, O Yehowah, about your way. I shall walk in your truth. Unify my heart to fear your name. (Psalms 86:11)

[Question] What did the Psalmist show, that he would faithfully walk in?

11. It is in vain that they keep worshiping me, because they teach as doctrines, commands of men. (Mark 7:7)

[Question] Why did Jesus tell men that they worshiped in vain?

12. For, as regards Yehowah, his eyes are roving about through all the earth to show his strength, in behalf of those whose heart is complete toward him. You have acted foolishly respecting this, for from now on, there will exist wars against you. (2 Chronicles 16:9)

[Question] What are the eyes of Yehowah God roving about searching for, among the sons of mankind?

13. For from the sun's rising even to its setting my name will be great among the nations, and in every place sacrificial smoke will be made, a presentation will be made to my name, even a clean gift, because my name will be great among the nations, Yehowah of armies has said. (Malachi 1:11)

[Question] What does Yehowah God state, that his name must become among the nations of the earth?

14. At that I fell down before his feet to worship him. But he tells me; Be careful! Do not do that! All I am is a fellow slave of you and of your brothers, who have the work of witnessing to Jesus. Worship God! For the bearing witness to Jesus, is what inspires prophesying. (Revelation 19:10)

[Question] What work do true Christians have, for what does bearing witness inspire?

15. And I did not see a temple in it, for Yehowah God the Almighty is its temple, also the Lamb is. (Revelation 21:22)

[Question] What does not even exist within the New Jerusalem, and why is one not necessary?
