

John 4:24~ God is a Spirit,¹ and those worshiping him must worship with spirit and truth.

Footnote: Literally, A Spirit [is] the God Greek, *Pneu'ma ho The'os*

1· Then Jesus told her, that God was a spirit, and all those worshipping his acceptably must worship with spirit and truth, for he will not accept anything less than this. So since this spirit is the life force within men, then they must worship with all this life force and in full harmony with the truth about him. This was appropriate for she was a Samaritan, and as such had accepted a way of worship, that was based upon man made tenets and falsehoods. Yet our true worship must always be in harmony with the truth about God.

[Question] What form is Yehowah God in?

[Question] How must all approaching to Yehowah God to worship him, worship him?

[Question] What is the spirit, and so how must men worship Yehowah God?

[Question] What must men know about Yehowah God, to worship him acceptably?

[Question] Why did Jesus then tell these things to a Samaritan woman?

[Question] What must our worship always be in harmony with?

2· Now Yehowah is the Spirit, and where the spirit of Yehowah is, there is freedom. (2 Corinthians 3:17)

[Question] What accompanies the presence of the spirit of Yehowah God?

3· Now to the King of eternity, incorruptible, invisible, the only God, be honor and glory forever and ever. Amen. (1 Timothy 1:17)

[Question] What things, is Yehowah God deserving of from his creation?

4· By faith, he left Egypt, but not fearing the anger of the king, for he continued steadfast, as seeing the One who is invisible. (Hebrews 11:27)

[Question] What kind of God is Yehowah God to his people, can they ever see him?

[Question] How though, did Moses see Yehowah God?

- 5· **Consequently I entreat you by the compassions of God, brothers, to present your bodies a sacrifice living, holy, acceptable to God, a sacred service with your power of reason. (Romans 12:1)**

[Question] How are anointed Christians told to present their living bodies as?

[Question] What power of mind and its exercise, is a sacred service to God?

- 6· **In the beginning God, created the heavens and the earth. (Genesis 1:1)**

[Question] Who created heaven and earth?

- 7· **Meanwhile the people got to see that Moses was taking a long time about coming down from the mountain. So the people congregated themselves about Aaron and said to him; Get up, make for us a god who will go ahead of us, because as regards this Moses, the man who led us up out of the land of Egypt, we certainly do not know what has happened to him. (Exodus 32:1)**

[Question] What did the people of Israel quickly revert back to worshipping, when their visible leader was out of sight?

[Question] What did this show about these men, and how they viewed all things spiritual?

- 8· **And he added; You are not able to see my face, because no man may see me, and yet live. (Exodus 33:20)**

[Question] Can any man actually see the face of Yehowah God, did even Moses, ever do so?

- 9· **And Yehowah began to speak to you out of the middle of the fire. The sound of words was what you were hearing, but no form were you seeing, nothing but a voice. (Deuteronomy 4:12)**

[Question] How did Yehowah God speak to the people of Israel, and did the people then see any form representing Yehowah God?

- 10· And now fear Yehowah and serve him in faultlessness and in truth, and remove the gods that your forefathers served on the other side of the River and in Egypt, and serve Yehowah. (Joshua 24:14)**

[Question] What did it mean for the Israelites to serve Yehowah God in trueness?

- 11· In order, that Yehowah may carry out his word that he spoke respecting me, saying; If your sons will take care of their way by walking before me in truth with all their heart and with all their soul, there will not be cut off a man of yours from sitting upon the throne of Israel. (1 Kings 2:4)**

[Question] What promise did Yehowah God make to Israel, if they walked before him in truth and sincerity of heart?

- 12· I beseech you, O Yehowah, remember, please, how I have walked before you in truthfulness and with a complete heart, and what was good in your eyes, I have done. And Hezekiah began to weep profusely. (2 Kings 20:3)**

[Question] Who did Hezekiah show, how he had walked before his God Yehowah throughout his life?

- 13· For my palate in low tones utters truth itself. And wickedness is something detestable to my lips. (Proverbs 8:7)**

[Question] What did the congregator say, that he would speak, and what was detestable to his lips?

- 14· Woe to those drawing error with ropes of untruth, and as with wagon cords, sin. (Isaiah 5:18)**

[Question] How did Isaiah illustrate, how men use lies to carry along their sins?

- 15· In the year that King Uzziah died, I however, got to see Yehowah, sitting on a throne lofty and lifted up, and his skirts were filling the temple. (Isaiah 6:1)**

[Question] What vision of the throne of Yehowah God did Isaiah the prophet see during the reign of King Uzziah of Judah?

- 16· And I proceeded to say; Woe to me! For I am as good as brought to silence, because a man unclean in lips I am, and**

in among a people unclean in lips, I am dwelling, for my eyes have seen the King, Yehowah of armies, himself! (Isaiah 6:5)

[Question] How did Isaiah come to feel, when in the presence of the Holy One?

[Question] Did Isaiah actually see Yehowah God, or did he see a vision of Yehowah God?

- 17· They will not go hungry, neither will they go thirsty, nor will parching heat or sun strike them. For the One who is having pity upon them will lead them, and by the springs of water he will conduct them. (Isaiah 49:10)**

[Question] What did Isaiah show, that Yehowah God would lead his covenant people to, and what would they not suffer for want of?

- 18· And he continued saying to me; Son of man, go, enter in among the house of Israel, and you **must** speak with my words to them. (Ezekiel 3:4)**

[Question] Who was the Son Of Man sent to, to speak whose message?

- 19· I am Yehowah your God. Walk in my own statutes, and keep my own judicial decisions and do them. (Ezekiel 20:19)**

[Question] What did Yehowah God tell his people to do, to gain a blessing?

- 20· Speak, and you **must** say; This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; Here I am against you, O Pharaoh, king of Egypt, the great sea monster lying stretched out in the midst of his Nile canals, that has said; My Nile River belongs to me, and I, I have made it for myself. (Ezekiel 29:3)**

[Question] How did Yehowah God come out against the Pharaoh of Egypt, who represents Satan the Devil?

[Question] How does Satan the Devil establish himself within the river of truth, the Bible, and the religions that grow from it? **[See Also Son Of Man – Prophecy To The Wind under this verse]**

- 21· And as a grain offering you should provide with it morning by morning the sixth of an ephah and, as regards oil, the**

third of a hin for sprinkling the fine flour. The grain offering to Yehowah is an indefinitely lasting statute, constantly. (Ezekiel 46:14)

[Question] How did Yehowah God establish the acts of true worship, and what did the daily offering of two lambs represent within Israel?

- 22· And an army itself was gradually given over, together with the constant feature, because of transgression, and it kept throwing truth to the earth, and it acted and had success. (Daniel 8:12)**

[Question] What does an army that is to come, throw down to the earth?

- 23· He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of all creation. (Colossians 1:15)**

[Question] What is Jesus like, in comparison to Yehowah God?

[Question] When did Jesus first come into existence?

- 24· Beloved ones, now we are children of God, but as yet it has not been made manifest what we shall be. We do know that whenever he is made manifest, we shall be like him, because we shall see him just as he is. (1 John 3:2)**

[Question] What are spirit anointed Christians now, and what will they later become?

[Question] Who then, will they be like, and what form did Jesus have in the beginning, as an only-begotten god?

- 25· At no time has anyone beheld God. If we continue loving one another, God remains in us and his love is made perfect in us. (1 John 4:12)**

[Question] Has any man seen Yehowah God while a man?

[Question] How do we make the love of God perfect or complete within ourselves?

- 26· And the third angel blew his trumpet. And a great star burning as a lamp fell from heaven, and it fell upon a third of the rivers and upon the fountains of waters. (Revelation 8:10)**

[Question] Where does the star called wormwood fall, and what do these fresh water sources represent spiritually? **[See also Revelation - An Unveiling under these verses]**

27· And they conquered him because of the blood of the Lamb and because of the word of their witnessing, and they did not love their souls, even in the face of death. (Revelation 12:11)

[Question] How do spirit anointed Christians conquer, and what do they put first in their lives?
