

John 4:29~ Come here, see a man that told me all the things I did. This is not perhaps the Christ, is it?

1· So she bore witness about Jesus, saying to the men, to come with her and see a man, who told her about all the things she did, yet whom she did not know. So she said to them, that perhaps this one was the Christ of God.

[Question] What then, did the woman tell the men of her village, and what did she say that this one might be, as she witnessed to them about her conversation with Jesus?

2· A prophet from your own midst, from your brothers, like me, is what Yehowah your God will raise up for you, to him you people should listen. (Deuteronomy 18:15)

[Question] What had Yehowah God promised through Moses to raise up for his people, from among them?

3· And yet, see! He is speaking in public, and they say nothing to him. The rulers have not come to know for a certainty, that this is the Christ, have they? (John 7:26)

[Question] What did people wonder as they heard Jesus speaking, in full view of the religious leaders, who hated him?

4· Now many of the Samaritans out of that city put faith in him on account of the word of the woman who said in witness; He told me all the things I did. (John 4:39)

[Question] Who then also came out to meet Jesus, and what then happened to them also?
