

John 4:34~ Jesus said to them; **My food, is for me to do the will of him that sent me, and to finish his work.**

- 1· So Jesus told them plainly that his food, that which sustained him in life, was the doing of his Father's will to a completion.

[Question] What then, did Jesus plainly tell them, was what sustained him in life?

- 2· But in reply he **said**; It is written: Man must live, not on bread alone, but on every utterance coming forth through Yehowah's mouth. (**Matthew 4:4**)

[Question] How did Jesus show from the Law Covenant, how men must live every day?

- 3· I cannot do a single thing of my own initiative. Just as I hear, I judge, and the judgment that I render is righteous, because I seek, not my own **will**, but the **will** of him that **sent** me. (**John 5:30**)

[Question] How did Jesus show, that he was not self-willed, and so what kind of judgments did he render?

- 4· Because I have come down from heaven to do, not my **will**, but the **will** of him that **sent** me. (**John 6:38**)

[Question] Whose will did Jesus come down to the earth to accomplish?

- 5· But I have the witness greater than that of John, for the very **works** that my Father assigned me to accomplish, the **works** themselves that I am doing, bear witness about me, that the Father dispatched me. (**John 5:36**)

[Question] What bore witness to all who saw them, that Jesus had the full support of Yehowah God?

- 6· I have glorified you on the earth, having finished the **work** you have given me to do. (**John 17:4**)

[Question] How did Jesus glorify Yehowah God's name on earth, and what did he accomplish?

- 7· When, now, he had received the sour wine, Jesus **said**; It

has been accomplished! And, bowing his head, he delivered up his spirit. (John 19:30)

[Question] What did Jesus bear witness to, that had been fully accomplished by the time of his death?

8· To do your **will**, O my God, I have delighted, and your Law is within my inward parts. (Psalms 40:8)

[Question] Why did Jesus come forth as the Messiah from God, and what was within him, and that he delighted in doing?

9· But Yehowah himself took delight in crushing him, he made him sick. If you **will** set his soul as a guilt offering, he **will** see his offspring, he **will** prolong his days, and in his hand, what is the delight of Yehowah, **will** succeed. (Isaiah 53:10)

[Question] Why did Yehowah God crush his son in death, and to fulfill what purpose of his?

10· And your **food** that you **will** eat **will** be by weight, twenty shekels a day. From time to time you **will** eat it. (Ezekiel 4:10)

[Question] How did Yehowah God's prophets exist on measured food supplies in the past, but what really sustained them?

11· And water you **will** drink merely by measure, the sixth part of a hin. From time to time you **will** drink. (Ezekiel 4:11)

[Question] How did the Son Of Man exist on measured drink also, and what did this depict for the future of Jerusalem?

12· And he that **sent** me is with me. He did not abandon me to myself, because I always do the things pleasing to him. (John 8:29)

[Question] Who was always with Jesus, and why did Yehowah God never abandon Jesus?

13· We must **work** the **works** of him that **sent** me while it is day, the night is coming when no man can **work**. (John 9:4)

[Question] What works did Jesus work while on earth, and why then?

14· Instead, you ought to say; If Yehowah **wills**, we shall live,

and also do this or that. (James 4:15)

[Question] How should men feel about the future, every day?
